Sir,

I, SI Dipak Kr. Nandi along with force return to PS and brought under seizure 01 (one) tractor having Chassis No- MBNABACAALRJ07650 & Engine No- RLJ2BBN1857 attached with sand loaded trolley (approx 100 cft). The fact in brief is that today (08/06/2023) I along with force namely i) C/214 Siddhartha Mandal and ii) C/1284 Pratapaditya Majhi were performing RT mobile-II duty in PS area vide Jhalda P.S. GDE No- 372 Dated- 08/06/2023 in consonance with Jhalda PS CC No- 1699/23 Dated- 08/06/2023. During my RT mobile-II duty I received credible source information that one Tractor was lifting & carrying sand illegally and coming from Kushi Ghat of Subarnarekha river & coming towards Jhalda Town side. Subsequently, I informed you and as per your gracious order, I placed Naka at Ichag more to work out this tip off and started Naka Checking after proper placing guard rail on the road. Thereafter I saw the one Tractor was proceeding towards Ichag more. Consequently, we intercepted the said Tractor at before Naka checking point at about 14:05 hrs and found that the vehicle as well as goods as identical as I received prior information. But seeing the Police Party driver of Tractor fled away leaving the Tractor on road before Naka checking point. We tried to apprehend him but failed. We waited for reasonable time but none came to spot. It was ascertained that the driver of the tractor loaded the said sand in cahoots with the owner of the vehicle by illegal means for selling the same to make profit by dishonestly and they had been running a clandestine business. So it is reasoned to belief that he in cahoots with the owner of the vehicle procured the said sand from Kushi Ghat of Subarnarekha River by fraudulently means or theft by any means for transporting the same to run clandestine business. Ergo I, seized the vehicle 01 (one) tractor having Chassis No- MBNABACAALRJ07650 & Engine No- RLJ2BBN1857 attached with sand loaded trolley (approx 100 cft) under proper seizure list in presence of available witnesses duly signed by them. Thereafter, I brought the said tractor to Jhalda PS compound.

Under the above facts and circumstances kindly take lawful action against the Owner & driver of the said vehicles as they committed offence U/S 379/411/414/120B of the IPC & 21 (1)(4) Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act-1957.
