3. THAT following contractors who ever dropping/bidding the tender as above names are 1. BIBHUTIBHUSAN DEOGORIA, 2. ADHITYA BOURI, 3. SUJIT GANGULY ..who has no any valid documents

- 4.- That the complainant's brother dropping the said tender but , above mention accused person was not entertained the valid bidding of tender, because above accused asking for cut money as liu of extortion demand by the above noted accused, which was not fulfilled by the brother of complainant. Sanjoy chakraborty. the said Tender was not awarded infavour of the complianant's brother. The accused persons were employed at panchayet and a letter of request also send to them. by the complainant as bonafide contractor and accused have in power to awarding the tender as official rules®ulation , which made will be free from coruption and any type of demand of money for award the Tender,.
- 4- That the work was not stopped by the panchayet as such the alongwith the accused persons were standing without any valid paper work and in view of this in order to find work for the 3/5/2023 the complainant went to the site then he find the accused persons there at the site.
- 5- That the complainant has enquired here and there about the work and the accused persons but could not found the same.
- 6- That thereafter the complainant had visited the village & panchayet office the accused persons therting to the complainant in view to abolished thew registration of contractors and complainant never succeed to dropping any Tender. and complainant meet met other contractor who are witnessed in this compliant petition proof the case of cheating , extortions demand of money. who told that the accused persons are daring and they have no heed of this crucial moment of complianat . for consideration of Rs. 8,00,00/- to some money demanded by the accused preparing forged papers and now they are running /operating the same in the panchayet .
- 7- That the complainant has made a number of visits in the office anara panchayet and in the area of to find out the proper remedies for his contract. But accused persons not to locate the

- 9- That the accused persons with the common intention hatched a conspiracy and thereby they dishonestly stopped the awarding the tender infaour of complainant, the complainant without the complainant's consent and further they moved the contract out of the reach of the complainant and they further fraudulently awarded other invalid contractor who are not contractor of said office or have no any valid paper. some one else without having any right to do and the accused have committed this offence while under the employment of the panchayet ,complainant and these illegal acts of the accused persons amounts to offences under section 387, 408,420,120-B IPC, hence they are liable to be prosecuted and punished by thisLd. court.
- 10- That the complainant resides at village ANARA __, Police Station PARA and the accused had committed the offences within the territorial jurisdiction of P.S.
