Subject: Complaint.

Respected Sir,

In producing here with 01 (One) seized Bolero Pick Up having Registration No. JH/10CB/8282 loaded with approx 3 TN coal seems to be steam coal and also taken sample of 02 kg coal from the Bolero Pick Up. On 03.06.2023 at about 20.15 hrs. I received a credible source information indicating that one Bolero Pick Up having Registration No. JH/10CB/8282 loaded with illegal coal is moving towards Chharra X-ing on Aimundih – Chharra X-ing by pass road. After receiving the information, I contacted with IC Purulia Mufassil Police Station and as per his direction, I, SI Subrata Sarkar along with Const. 531-Shibsankar Mahanty and Const. 1147- Bappaditya Nandi both of Purulia (M) PS, Dist. Purulia, vide Purulia (M) PS Spl. CC No. 2074/23, dtd. 03.06.2023, left PS work out the information at about 20:15 hrs. this refers to Purulia (M) PS GDE No. 156, dtd. 03.06.2023. We reached near Nadiara village more at about 20:40 hrs. and contacted with my source. At about 20:55 hrs. as per identification of my source we have managed to apprehend a Bolero Pick Up van bearing registration no. JH/10CB/8282, but on seeing the Police party the driver of the said vehicle managed to escape leaving the vehicle beside the Aimundih – Charrah X-ing By-pass Road at Nadiara village more. On searching the vehicle no valid documents in respect of loaded coal was found. On preliminary enquiry it could be learnt that the driver along with the owner of the vehicle were procured the said illegal coal from different places and transporting the same in a clandestine manner to another district/state. So, it is reasonable to believe that they were transporting the coal illegally after procuring. Accordingly, I seized the above noted vehicles loaded with coal under proper seizure list duly signed by the accompanied Police persons as there was no availability of any local person, as such I could not collect the signature of the local people in all seizure list and during seizure, I had taken 02 Kg coal from the truck as sample. After that we made proper arrangement and brought the vehicles loaded with coal at PS to keep at PS compound.

Therefore, I pray that a specific case may kindly be registered against the unknown driver and the owner of the vehicle above noted, and other associates under proper section of law.
