

The above name complainant begs to state as follows:





- That the complainant is the permanent resident village & P.O.
   Badaldih, P.S. Barabazar, Dist- Purulia and within the jurisdiction of the Ld. Court.
- 2) That the complainant is the legally married of the accused of Mahadeb Mahato and their marriage was solemnized on 21/11/2021 as per Hindu Rites and Customs as prevalent in our community and also by observing the formalities like putting on vermilion, exchange of garlands, Home etc and the said marriage is still subsisting.
- That at the time of marriage as per demand of the accused persons, the father of the complainant had to pay a cash of Rs. 2,50,000/-, golden ornament weighing of 4 bhories, silver ornament weighing 6 bhories, Almirah, Colour Television and utensils including various type of articles.
- 4) That after marriage the complainant went to her matrimonial house and started to reside with the accused no-1 Mahadeb Mahato as husband and wife along with other inmates of the family in the same house and roof, initially the above noted Page 3 of 8





accused persons behave with the complainant well and good for few months..


- 5) That the accused no-1 is a Government Employee under West Bengal Police and posted at Jalpaiguri Camp and sometime after marriage the complainant was taken at Jalpaiguri and was residing therein with the accused no-1 till 29/05/2023.
- house and at Jalpaiguri she without any reason whatsoever inflected torture both mental as well physical upon her by the accused no-1 and his inmates, even the complainant was not provided proper food and clothing even daily necessities. However, the complainant managed to stay with the accused no-1 for good days. But gradually persistent torture was/ is increased upon the complainant which caused mental pressure upon her and it was unbearable for the complainant.
- 7) That while the complainant and her husband accused no-1 both are in their native village and the complainant was taken her at





Purulia Court and under the instruction and pressure of the accused no-1, the complainant had put her signature upon different document before a lawyer. Even she was not allowed to go through the contents of the documents nor the complainant was disclose about the contents of the documents both by the opposite party and his lawyer. Out of fear the complainant did not disclose the matter before any one.

foul play on the part of the accused no-1 and accordingly the complainant put pressure upon the accused no-1 to give her the Xerox copy of the documents, so that she could know the contents thereof. The accused no-1 is very much angry and assaulted upon the complainant mercilessly and also driven out from her matrimonial house on 29/05/2023 and at that time the accused no-1 disclosed that unless the complainant bring a further dowry of Rs. 1,00,000/- at a least the complainant will not be allowed to stay in her matrimonial house.



- 9) That since the complainant was driven out from her matrimonial house she is residing at her paternal house, but the accused persons did not taken any information nor take any steps for bring her back at her matrimonial house even the accused no-1 changed his Mobile SIM and accordingly the complainant failed to make contact with the accused no-1 through cell phone.
- 10) That it is very significant to point out that the accused no-1 is not willing to keep the complainant in his house or to continue the matrimonial relationship. As the accused no-1 once disclosed that he will marry again with a fair girl and will get sufficient cash etc as the accused no-1 is the permanent employee under the Government of West Bengal.
- 11) That the accused persons committed various offences punishable under the Indian penal code for which they are deserved to be punished under the law.





Barabazar P.S. against the accused person but the said Officerin-charge did not taken any legal action after passage of
considerable time then the complainant lodged another
complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia but with
same fate, then the complainant is under compelling
circumstances is filing this complaint before the Ld. Court for
appropriate reliefs under the law.

It is therefore, prayed that your honour may be pleased to sent the petition of complaint to the Officer-in-charge Barabazar P.S. for treating the same as FIR under section 156(3) for investigation.

#### Mahadeb Mahato and 9 others

Petitioner Babita Mahato filed an application u/s156(3) CrP.C against the accused persons Mahadeb Mahato and 9 others with a prayer to send the same to the O/C Barabazar Ps for investigation by treating the same as F.I.R along with an affidavit stating that no case has been initiated upon the same allegation before any P.S.

Perused the petition and photo copies of ducuments. It appears that a cognizable case is made out. Thus the petition u/s 156(3) CrP.C is allowed. The O/C Barabazar Ps is directed to ivestigate the case as per law treating the petition as F.I.R and to report compliance, with a direction to submit report within one month.

Let the complaint along with copy of order be sent to the O/C Barabazar Ps concerned.
