The complainant above named begs to state as follows :-

1. That the Complainant is a permanent resident of Village Simultanrd, within P. S. Joypur. The said Complainant and his co-sharers have got a tank and its ail at Mouza Bangidiri, within P. S. Joypur bearing R. S./ L. R. Plot No's. 2190 and 2191 measuring an area of 5.29 Acres and 47 decimals respectively.
2. That the said tank and its ail is known as Nimu Bandh and in L. R. operation the said tank has been duly recorded in the name of the complainant and his other co-sharers.

3. That the said Tank and its ail is the ancestral property of the Complainant and his other co-sharers and and the predecessor of the Complainant and his co-sharers have/had obtained/acquired the tank from the land-lady Brajaraj Kumari Devi on the basis of Registered Patta in the year 1951 dated 19.3.1951.

4. That the predecessor-in-interest of the Complainant after obtaining the tank made deeper by spending money and labour and used to rear and catch fishes.

5. That at present the Complainant and his other co-sharers are in possession of the tank and its ail by rearing and catching fishes and by irrigating their land which are lying adjacent to the tank.

6. That there were/are good number of sh fishes in the said tank reared and nurtured by the Complainant and his other co-sharers.

7. That on 4.6.2023 at about 3 A.M. the accused persons armed with Da, Sickle, Rod and Fishing Nylon Net illegally and criminally trespassed into the tank with an intention to catch fishes.

8. That the Complainant and his other co-sharers obtained information that some persons with armed with Nylon Net in their hands assembled on the ail of the tank for illegal purpose.

9. That after getting information the Complainant and his co-sharers, witness No's. 2 and 3 namely Niranjan Mahato, Sahadeb Mahato along with other persons immediately had been to that tank and the complainant and his witnesses found that the accused persons were catching fishes from the ~~ent~~ tank with the help of Nylon Net. The complainant and his witnesses protested against the high handed activities of the accused persons but the accused persons ~~threatened~~ to kill the complainant and his witnesses with the help of their arms.

10. That the accused persons are/were large in numbers and they ~~are~~ were equipped with arms, so the complainant and his witnesses No. 2 and 3 became nervous and thereafter other witnesses came to the spot and that in presence of the Complainant and other witnesses the accused persons forcibly caught fishes weighing about 200 Kgs.

11. That the accused persons after catching fishes kept the same in ~~a~~ Plasticbags which they carried and further kept the same in a Matador Van and they left the place hurriedly.

12. That as the accused persons were armed with weapons so the complainant and his ~~se~~ witnesses could not raise any objection, though they shown the entire incident in their own eyes.

13. That the accused persons have no right, title, interest and possession in the tank.

14. That the fishes which were caught and removed by the accused persons were reared and nurtured by the complainant and his other co-sharers.

15. That on 5.6.2023 the Complainant and witness No's. 2 and 3 lodged complaint before I.C. Baghlata by Registered Post with Ack-Due.

16. That as no action was taken, so the Complainant lodged information before the Superintendent of Police, Purulia on 13.6.2023 intimating the entire incident.

17. That the accused persons after forming an unlawful assembly criminally trespassed into the tank of the complainant and his co-sharers and illegally caught fishes. The value of the fishes, taken by the accused persons will be about Rs.30,000/-. So the complaint sustained a loss of Rs.30,000/-.

18. That the Complainant is a poor persons and he is not in a position to prosecute the case & in his personal capacity. So the complainant invoked the provisions Under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C.

19. That the tank is situated under the jurisdiction of Baghlata I.C., P.S. Joypur.
