The complainant most respectfully sheweth:-

1. That last 14-06-2023 like other days, the complainant usually go to his grocers shop at Anara Bazar leaving his parents at his residence.
2. That at the very day the accused persons in furtherance of common intention illegally entered to the petitioner's house and started using filthy language to the parents of the petitioner/complainant and the accused persons demanded to get back the ornaments of their daughter. And in response the parents of the complainant told your daughter took back entire ornaments along with her when she left.
3. That hearing all the accused persons snatched the key of the almirah by threatening and thereafter opening the almirah, the accused persons, forcibly took an amount of Rs:-20/25 thousand
4. That at the same time when the parents of the complainant protested not to take said amount from the almirah the acced. persons assaulted cruelly the complainant's father/mother etc.
