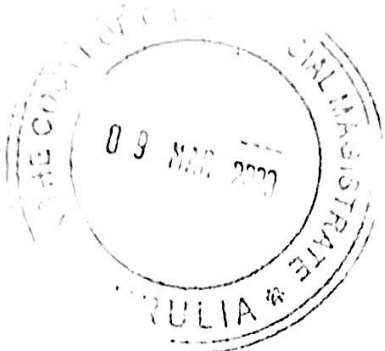



- 10) That from the above, it is well establish that the accused fraudulently and dishonestly withdraw the money without the consent and knowledge of the complainant by inducing the concerned authority and thereby cheated the complainant of a huge money for which it is also well proved it caused wrongfully and loss to the complainant and gain to the accused Sudhir Chandra Mandal for which the accused persons is liable to published under the law.
- 11) That the accused persons committed various offences punishable under the Indian penal code for which they are deserved to be punished under the law.
