The above name complainant begs to state as follows:

- 1) That the complainant is the permanent resident of resident of village- Majurdubi, P.S. Chandankiyari, Dist- Bokaro, Jharkhand and the accused persons are the resident village-Bagda, P.S. Puncha, Dist- Purulia and within the jurisdiction of the Ld. Court
- 2) That the complainant is the legally married wife of the accused no-1 Ratan Mitra and their marriage was solemnized on 9th Ashar-1420 B.S. as per Hindu Rites and Customs as prevalent in their community and also by observing the formalities like putting on vermilion, exchange of garlands, Home etc and the said marriage is still subsisting, in their wedlock one daughter namely Mallika Mitra and a son Durgadas Mitra were born.

- That at the time of marriage as per demand of the accused persons father of the complainant had to pay a cash of Rs. 1,50,000/-, golden ornament weighing of 2½ bhories, silver ornament weighing 3 bhories, Almirah, Colour Television, Furniture and utensils including various type of articles.
  - That after marriage the complainant went to her matrimonial house and started to reside with Ratan Mitra as husband and wife along with other inmates of the family in the same house and roof. For some years after their marriage husband of the complainant and other in-laws of the family behaved well and good but particularly after birth of the son the above noted accused persons for the reason best known to them started all sorts of inhuman, physical as well as mental torture upon the complainant the accused persons also even did not provided proper food and clothing and sometime they stopped supply food even they assaulted the complainant mercilessly with the help of lathi keeping her in a house bolted from inside so that the neighboring people could not know such torture inflicted by the above noted accused persons causing physical as well as mental torture





upon the complainant for a pretty long time, they also tried to blamed towards her character. Even the accused persons sometimes driven out from their house.

However, bearing all such torture the complainant tried her level best to continue her matrimonial life by staying in her matrimonial house. When persistent torture inflicted upon the complainant by the above noted accused persons became very much unbearable then the complainant reported the matter to her parents, relations and others, when there was social meeting and the above noted accused persons pledged their guild, but promise to keep the complainant with proper prestige and care, the matter was also reported to Puncha P.S. then the Police also asked the husband of the complainant and other in-laws to compromise the matter and to keep in their house without inflicting any type of torture upon the complainant.

Thereafter, the accused persons allowed the complainant to stay in their house but after few months they did not keep their promise and ask the complainant to bring





a cash of Rs. 50,000/- form her father's house as additional dowry, and when her father could not fulfilled their illegal demand they on 29/09/2021 assaulted the complainant and keeping all her personal belongings/ stridhan etc. including her Voter Identity Card, Aadhar Card and valuable ornaments driven her out from their house and at the same time they also snatched her son Durgadas Mitra and keep him in their house and threatened the complainant that if she dare to enter in to her matrimonial house in that the accused persons will kill her and disappear her dead body so that none can found her dead body.

- 5) That the accused persons committed various offences punishable under the Indian penal code for which they are deserved to be punished under the law.
- Puncha P.S. against the accused persons but the said Officer-in-charge in-charge did not taken any legal action then the complainant lodged another complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia but with same fate, then the complainant is





under compelling circumstances is filing this complaint before the Ld. Court for appropriate reliefs under the law.

It is therefore, prayed that your honour may be pleased to sent the petition of complaint to the Officer-in-charge Puncha P.S. for treating the same as FIR under section 156(3) for investigation.
