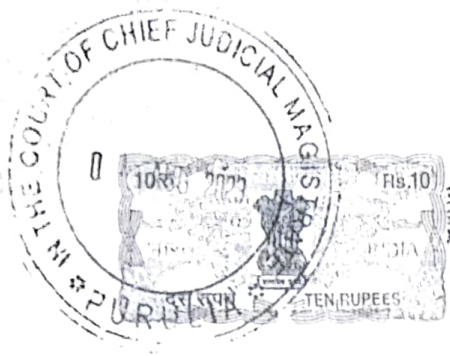

2. That the complainant is the registered owner of the motor cycle (Royal Enfield) bearing Registration No. WB- 56U/0333, Engine No. D4A5F1ND170055, Chassis No. ME3D4B5FIND001223 year of Mfg. 04/2022.
3. That on the date of occurrence i.e., on 01/03/2023 at about 12.00 noon the accused person who is known to the complainant came at the house of the complainant and the accused person asked to the complainant that they have agreed to sell to their residential house which stand recorded in his mother's name and a sum of Rs. 50,000/- is urgently needed as an advance amount. The complainant agreed to the proposal of the accused person and on good faith the complainant paid a sum of Rs. 50,000/- in cash <sup>to</sup> the complainant and then the complainant asked him to supply a receipt of the said amount.
4. That thereafter the accused person requested to the complainant to hand over the aforesaid motor cycle bearing No. WB-56U/0333 of the complainant for a few minutes and assured to the complainant to ~~bring~~ <sup>bring</sup> back the aforesaid motor cycle and receipt of Rs. 50,000/- of her mother's signature and original documents relating to the residential house of the accused person and then the accused person took away the said motor cycle from the house of the complainant in presence of the witnesses Nos. 2 and 4.
5. That while the accused person did not turn up after an hour then the complainant has enquired here and there of the accused person and his motor cycle but could not found the same.
6. That thereafter the complainant had visited the Mohalla of the accused person as well as the house of the accused person, wherein the complainant could not found the accused person and motor cycle. The complainant came to know from neighbour of the accused person that the mother of the accused person died long ago.
7. That then the complainant collected the Mobile Phone Nos. of the accused person vide Mobile Nos. 7699680069 and 8637029939. The complainant tried to talk/communicate over mobile phone with the accused person on various times, but the accused person did not pay any heed over the same and lastly the accused person switch off the said mobile phones.

8. That the complainant on reliable sources came to know that the accused person has grab the amount of Rs. 50,000/- dishonestly from the complainant by way of cheating and also the accused person has stolen away the said motor cycle of the complainant bearing No. WB-56U/0333 and now he stays at Kolkata and the accused person attempted to sell the said motor cycle by preparing forged papers to other person.
9. That the complainant informed the matter to the I.C. Purulia(T) P.S. on 14/07/2023 but the Police refused to receive the same and then the complainant submitted complaint against the accused person to the Superintendent of Police Purulia on 14/07/2023, but of no good.
10. That thus the accused person dishonestly stolen the motor cycle of the complainant without the complainant's consent and further he fraudently cheated the complainant by grabbing the amount of Rs. 50,000/- and hence he is liable to be prosecuted and punished by this Id. Court according to Law.
11. That the complaint of the complainant needs to be thoroughly investigated by the Police as well as said motor cycle and money is to be recovered from the accused person which can only be done by the Police and hence the complaint is being filed today before this Id. Court.

It is, therefore, prayed that your Honour will be graciously pleased to send this petition of complainant to the Inspector-in-Charge, Purulia (Town) P.S. under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. for lodging the F.I.R. and investigate the case for the ends of Justice.
