Sir,

In producing herewith two vehicles (i) one seized truck having Reg. No. JH-02AD-6957 loaded with black coloured palette like object seems to be Sponge Iron palette whose approx weight is 24 tn. (Twenty four tonnes approx) (ii) one seized Bolero Pick-Up van having Reg. No. WB-55B-0226 loaded with silver coloured stone like object seems to be lump of Manganese - Silicone alloy whose approx weight is 1tn(one tones approx). The matter of the fact in brief is that on 27.08.2023 at about 16:05 hours I received a credible source of information that in Chharrah area some important and valuably rare minerals is been loaded and transported to different places illegally. After receiving this information I discussed the matter with I/C Purulia (M) PS and as per his direction I SI Shoumik Acharyya along with C/699 Biswajit Banerjee and C/3150 Subodh Bauri both of Purulia (M) PS, left the PS vide GDE No. 1430 dtd. 27.08.2023 and vide Purulia (M) PS spl. CC No. 266/2023 dtd. 27.08.2023 by registered govt. vehicle. We reached at Chharrah X-ing where my source clearly indicated towards nearby scrap dealer place. As per source information at about 17:35 hours I along with force held raid in scrap dealer's place situated at opposite side of Chharra Line Hotel where some persons were loading the above mentioned minerals in those two vehicles, but on realizing the arrival of the police team, the drivers and the other persons who were involved in procurement and transportation of these valuable minerals managed to escape leaving those two vehicles loaded with the aforesaid minerals at that place. On searching the vehicles no valid documents in respect of these minerals could be found. On preliminary enquiry it was revealed that the owner of this place is one Sambhu Gupta, S/o Lt. Sudama Gupta, resident of Barakar road, Purulia Municipality Ward No. 21, PS- Purulia (T), Dist-Purulia and the owner of this scrap dealing place along with his co-workers (other associates) were involved in illegal procurement and transportation of the different minerals in illegal manner to different places. Accordingly I seized both the above noted vehicles loaded with different minerals under proper seizure list duly signed by accompanying Police persons and disinterested public as witnesses in between 18:05 hours to 18:35 hours. I had taken 02 (two) kgs of seized minerals from both the vehicles as sample. After that proper arrangement was made to bring the seized vehicles loaded with different minerals at PS compound as safe custody.

Therefore, I pray that a specific case may kindly be registered against the owner of this place namely Sambhu Gupta, S/o- Lt. Sudama Gupta, resident of Barakar road, Purulia Municipality Ward No. 21, PS- Purulia (T), Dist-Purulia and unknown drivers and owners of the above noted seized vehicles and their other associates under proper sections of law.
