Sir,  
In producing herewith the driver cum owner namely Rupchand Kumar @ Kalachand (42 yrs) S/O- Lt. Hanuman Kumar of Vill- Dava, P.S- Balarampur, Dist- Purulia along with seized Tractor, vide its Registration No- WB55B/3197 and its Chassis No- MBNABAEXPJKD04787, Engine No- NKD2EMJ0056 attached with Sand loaded Trolley (approx 50 cft) and with Seizure list, Memo of Arrest and Inspection Memo in respect of the supra persons before you.

The nub of the fact in a nutshell is that on 23.09.2023 at 20:35 hrs while I along with force 1) C/572 Babunath Hembram and 2) C/246 Chanchal Chakraborty both of Balarampur PS left the PS for performing Evening mobile duty, vide Balarampur PS CC No 3797 date- 23.09.2023 and GDE No 1035 Dt. 23.09.2023 in PS area. During my evening mobile duty, I received a tip off information at 20:15 hrs that a suspicious tractor was loading sand at Sankha River Ghat near Dava village and will be proceeding towards Dava village. I informed the matter to O/C Balarampur P.S and as per his kind direction, I along with force proceeded towards Sankha River Ghat as well as Dava village for work out the tip off information. While I along with force arrived at Dava village at about 21:05 hrs and found 01 (one) sand loaded tractor was proceeding towards Dava village. I along with force intercepted the vehicle (Tractor) vide its Registration No- WB55B/3197 which attached with Sand loaded Trolley at near the house of Rupchand Kumar of Dava village and I found the vehicle as well as goods as identical as I received prior information. On being asked, the driver of the said vehicle disclosed his name as noted in the supra as well as informed me that he is the owner of the vehicle. I asked the driver of the vehicle to produce the valid documents in respect of the vehicle as well as the Sand loaded vehicle. But the driver of the said vehicle could not able to produce any kind of documents in respect of the Tractor and the sand. I repeatedly asked the driver to produce the valid paper but he stated differently in different times. The incoherent statement of the driver purported to be a suspicious to us. It was ascertained that the driver of the tractor loaded the said sand in vehicle by illegal means for selling the same to make profit by dishonestly and he have been running a clandestine business. So it is reasoned to belief that he in cahoots with the others of the vehicle procured the said sand form Sankha river side by fraudulently means or theft by any means for transporting the same to run clandestine business. So I, seized the Tractor vide its Registration No- WB55B/3197 and its Chassis No- MBNABAEXPJKD04787, Engine No- NKD2EMJ0056 attached with Trolley in which loaded approx 50 cft Sand under proper seizure list in presence of available witnesses duly signed by him and also arrested the driver namely Rupchand Kumar @ Kalachand (42 yrs) S/O- Lt. Hanuman Kumar of Vill- Dava, P.S- Balarampur, Dist- Purulia after informing the ground of his arrest after maintaining all formalities and issued Memo of Arrest and Inspection Memo against him.

Thereafter, I brought the seized tractor to Balarampur PS compound and under the above facts and circumstances kindly take lawful action against the driver namely Rupchand Kumar@ Kalachand (42 yrs) S/O- Lt. Hanuman Kumar of Vill- Dava, P.S- Balarampur, Dist- Purulia of the vehicle as he committed offence U/S 379/411/414 of the IPC & 21(1) (4) of Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act-1957.
