
I, ASI Surendra Nath Soren along with force returned to PS and brought 04 (four) seized Tractors attached with 04 (four) trolley having Registration No 1) WB56U/3229, 2) WB55A/9328, 3) WB55/8836 & 4) Engine No- RPK4SBA0042, Chassis No- MBNTFAUBEPRK00825 loaded with total approx 320 cft. sand. The fact in brief is that today (02.10.2023) I along with force namely C/2312 Rajendra Nath Bera & C/2755 Swapan Mandal were performing day mobile duty at Balarampur P.S area vide Balarampur P.S GDE No- 56 Dated- 02.10.2023 in c/w Balarampur P.S C.C No- 3976 Dated- 02.10.2023. During my day mobile duty I received a credible source information that 4 (four) Tractors were lifting & carrying sand illegally and coming from Nimdih side (Jharkhand) through Dantia which is Jharkhand Purulia Border & coming towards Balarampur. Subsequently, I informed you and as per your order, I placed Naka at Berma village morh on NH-32 to work out this information and started Naka Checking after proper placing guard rail on the NH-32 road. Thereafter I saw the 4 (four) tractors were proceeding towards Balarampur. Consequently, when we intercepted the said Tractors at Naka checking point at about 13:45 hrs but seeing the Police party, 4 (four) tractors along with sand loaded trolley turned around and flee away from there. We manage to apprehend the said 4 (four) tractors and we were able to detain the said 04 (four) tractors bearing Registration No 1) WB56U/3229, 2) WB55A/9328, 3) WB55/8836 & 4) Engine No- RPK4SBA0042, Chassis No- MBNTFAUBEPRK00825 along with total approx 320 cft sand loaded trolley but the accused driver flee away. We tried to apprehend them but failed. We waited for reasonable time but none came to spot. It was ascertained that the drivers of the tractors loaded the said sand in cahoots with the owners of the Tractors by illegal means for selling the same to make profit by dishonestly and they had been running a clandestine business. So it is reasonable to belief that they in cahoots with the owners of the offending tractors procured the said sand from River under Nimdih P.S area (Jharkhand) by fraudulently means or theft by any means for transporting the same to run clandestine business. So I, seized the 04 (four) tractors attached with 04 (four) trolley having Registration No 1) WB56U/3229, 2) WB55A/9328, 3) WB55/8836 & 4) Engine No- RPK4SBA0042, Chassis No- MBNTFAUBEPRK00825 loaded with total approx 320 cft. sand under proper seizure list in presence of witnesses duly signed by them. Thereafter, I brought the said 04 (four) tractors along with sand loaded 04 (four) Trolley to Balarampur P.S compound.

Under the above facts and circumstances kindly take lawful action against the Owners & drivers of the said offending 04 (four) tractors as they committed offence U/S 379/411/414 of the IPC & 21 (1)(4) Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act-1957
