Sir,

1, SI Malay Rajak along with force returned to PS and brought 05 (five) seized Tractors attached with 05 (five) trolley having Registration No 1) One Blue colour Tractor having registration No- WB55B/2880 (Model-New Holland 3037) loaded with approx 50 cft. sand, 2) One Blue colour Tractor having registration No- WB55A/7597 (Model-New Holland 3037) loaded with approx 50 cft. sand, 3) One Blue colour Tractor having registration No- WB55A/7567 (Model-Swaraj 735FE) loaded with approx 50 cft. sand, 4) One Blue colour Tractor having registration No- WB55B/1855 (Model-Sonalika DI35) loaded with approx 50 cft. sand, 5) One Red colour Tractor having registration No- WB55B/2647 (Model-Mahindra B275 DI) loaded with approx 50 cft. sand. The fact in brief is that today (08.10.2023) I along with force namely C/1470 Nandadulal Mandal, C/105 Saraoj Biswas, and CD/1375 Amal Rana were performing mobile duty at Balarampur P.S area vide Balarampur P.S GDE No- 354 Dated- 08.10.2023 in c/w Balarampur P.S C.C No- 4105 Dated- 08.10.2023. During my mobile duty I received a credible source information that 5 (five) Tractors were lifting & carrying sand illegally and coming from Sirkabad village side through Sirkabad village moram road which is coming towards Baraurma. Subsequently, I informed you and as per your order, I work out the said information. Thereafter myself along with force held raid at Sirkabad village near Kumari river and found the above noted 5 (five) tractors were proceeding towards Baraurma. Consequently, when we intercepted the said Tractors at about 15:45 hrs but seeing the Police party, 5 (five) tractors along with sand loaded trolley turned around and flee away from there. We manage to apprehend the said above noted 5 (five) tractors and we were able to detain the said 05 (five) tractors but the driver of above noted tractors flee away. We tried to apprehend them but failed. We waited for reasonable time but none came to spot. It was ascertained that the drivers of the tractors loaded the said sand in cahoots with the owners of the Tractors by illegal means for selling the same to make profit by dishonestly and they had been running a clandestine business. So it is reasonable to belief that they in cahoots with the owners of the offending tractors procured the said sand from Kumari River under Balarampur P.S area by fraudulently means or theft by any means for transporting the same to run clandestine business. So I, seized the 05 (five) tractors attached with 05 (five) trolley having Registration No 1) WB55B/2880, 2) WB55A/7597, 3) WB55A/7567, 4) WB55B/1855 & 5) WB55B/2647 and loaded with 50 cft sand each under proper seizure list in presence of witnesses duly signed by them. Thereafter, I brought the said 05 (five) tractors along with sand loaded 05 (five) Trolley to Balarampur P.S compound.

Under the above facts and circumstances kindly take lawful action against the Owners & drivers of the said offending 05 (five) tractors as they committed offence U/S 379/411/414 of the IPC & 21 (1)(4) Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act-1957
