Respected Sir / Madam

With reference to the above, I introduce myself as Deepak Kumar Agarwal father of "SRISHTY AGARWAL"; s/o Late Puranmal Agarwal resident of KIRKEND BAZAR, P.O. KUSUNDA ; Police Station : PUTKI ; District : Dhanbad, JHARKHAND.

My daughter Srishty Agarwal got married on 18th April 2018 to Sanki Agarwal s/o Sharwan Agarwal, resident of Murlidhar Rathi Lane, PURULIA, WEST BENGAL. She have a child named KUSH aged about 3 years.

Recently, we came to know that she was not happy residing in this family. I had some information that she was under pressure of dowry demands and domestic violence was happening with her by her husband and in laws noted below.

I received the news of my daughter's death on 21st October 2023 at around 5.00 pm in the evening. Immediately, on knowing this tragic news, I reached here on 22nd October 2023.

I tried to enquire about the reason of death from her in laws i.e.

1. her husband : Sanki Agarwal
2. her father in law : Sharwan Agarwal
3. her mother in law : name not known

but I did not get any satisfactory reply from her above mentioned in laws end. Further, when I wanted to see the dead body of my daughter, I came to know that the dead body was kept in police custody.

In the meantime, yesterday on 23rd October 2023, when I first saw her dead body, I was totally upset on seeing the major injury marks on her forehead, a big red mark below the jaw on the right side, injuries on her hand, injuries on her foot etc. I have suspicion about her death.

I tried to enquire about these injury marks from her above mentioned in laws but again I could not get any answer from their side. The above noted in laws are directly involved behind her death.

In light of the above, we request your good office to treat this complaint as F.I.R. and to take necessary legal action for which I shall be highly obliged.
