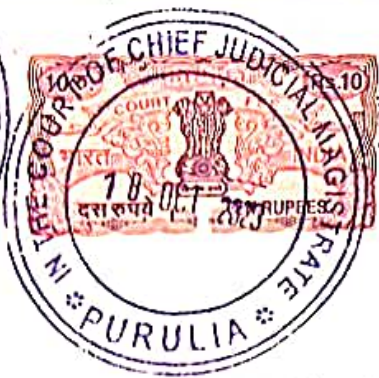

The above-named complainant beg to state as follows :-

1. That the complainant is the legally married wife of the accused no.1 and their marriage was solemnized on 09.03.2022 corresponding to 24<sup>th</sup> Falgun, 1428 B.S. according to the hindu rites and customs prevalent in their community.

2. That the accused no.1 is the husband , accused no.2. father-in-law, accused no.3 is the mother-in-law, accused no.4 is the sister-in-law of the complainant.

3. That at the time of marriage the father of the complainant gave cash of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Two lakhs), one almirah, palank, dressing table, big size trunk, and various utensils valued at Rs. 40,000/- and clothing as per demand of her in-law's house.

4. That after marriage the complainant went to her matrimonial home with her husband i. e, accused no.1 and had been residing their with him as husband and wife.

5. That after few days of their marriage ,the accused no.1 demanded one I. Phone but the father of the complainant did not full fill such unjustified demand. As a result all the accused persons started inhuman physical and mental torture upon the complainant. The accused no.1 used to come home at late night in drunken condition and used to assault the complainant without any reason whatsoever. All the accused persons always used to blame the complainant by saying her hunchback and bent neck . And they did not used to like her. Not only that but also the accused nos. 2 to 4, parents and sister of the accused no.1 often used to say that they will give his marriage for the second time after taking dowry. Even the accused no.1 used to assault the complainant in presence of his family member and they used to insist the accused no.1 to finish her . The complainant reported the matter to her parents and they on several times requested the accused persons to keep their daughter peacefully. In this way the complainant had been spending in her matrimonial home with very difficulties and bore all such things with a hope that on passage of time if the behaviour of the accused no.1 and other accused persons are changed in future.

6. That due to unbearable torture, the complainant on 30.06.2022 corresponding to 15<sup>th</sup> Ashar, 1429 B.S. informed the matter to her father over telephone and thereafter on the next day her father and other relatives came to her matrimonial home and requested the accused persons, not to torture upon the complainant, keep her peacefully but the accused persons abused her father in filthy languages in presence of her relatives. Then under compulsion, the father of the complainant brought her in his house. Thereafter the complainant on several times tried to contact with her husband i.e. the accused no.1 over telephone but he did not receive the call. The complainant informed the matter to Chatuhasa Gram Panchayat for reconciliation but the accused no.1 to 3 abused the complainant and her father with filthy languages even they tried to assault her father, anyhow he was saved with the help of their relatives . After some days , being helpless father of the complainant reached his daughter i.e. the complainant at her in laws house and requested the accused persons with folded hands, to keep their daughter peacefully. In spite of that the accused no.1 did not provide food and clothing to the complainant properly. Bearing all such things, the complainant had been spending at her marital life.

7. That on 22.04.2023 corresponding to 8<sup>th</sup> Baisakh, 1430 B.S. In the morning the accused persons assaulted the complainant mercilessly and drove her out from her matrimonial home. Finding no other alternative the complainant took shelter at her father house.

That thereafter the complainant lodged a written complaint against the accused persons before the O.C., Balarampur, P.S. by post but when the police did not take any step against the accused persons, then the complainant lodged a written complaint against the accused persons before the Superintendent of Police, Purulia on 12.10.2023 but till now no action has been taken against the accused persons.

It is, therefore, prayed that your Honour would be graciously pleased to send this petition of complaint to the O.C., Balarampur, P.S. as contemplated under section 156 (3) of the Cr. P.C. for investigation after treating it as F.I.R. for the interest of justice
