Sub: Prayer for lodging FIR.

Sir,

In producing herewith the arrested alleged driver namely Sk Raju (32 Yrs) S/o- Lt. Sk Anwar of J.K. College Road, Police Line, Purulia, Ward No.- 15, PS- Purulia (T), Dist- Purulia and seized Pick Up Van having registration No- JH 09AN 6511 loaded with approx 30 (Thirty) quintal coal and also taken sample of 02 kg coal from the Pick Up Van.

I beg to state that on 12.11.2023 at about 14:45 hrs while I, SI Soumen Kr. Panda along with C/- 497 Ambuj Kr. Mandal, NVF/571- Bhakta Ranjan Paramanik both of Purulia (M) PS, Dist- Purulia, vide Purulia (M) C.C No- 5160/2023, Dtd. 12.11.2023 and GDE No- 627 Dtd. 12.11.2023 were performing mobile duty at PS area, I received information from my source that one Pick Up Van having registration No- JH 09AN 6511 loaded with illegal coal is going towards Bhangra Morh through Chharrah-Bhangra by pass road through aerodrome. After receiving the information I contacted you and as per guidance and instruction we left that place to track and stopped this illegal transportation of coal. After a long chase I managed to stop the vehicle at Chharra aerodrome under Purulia (M) PS at about 15:05 hrs. On seeing the Police party the driver of the vehicle tried to flee away but we managed to apprehend him. On being asked the apprehended person disclosed his identity noted above. On demand he failed to produce any valid document in respect of loaded coal. On preliminary enquiry it could be learnt that the driver along with the owner of the said vehicle were procuring the said illegal coal from different places and transporting the same in a clandestine manner to another district/state. So, it is reasonable to believe that they were transporting the coal illegally after procuring.

Accordingly I seized the above noted vehicles loaded with coal approx 30 Quintal under proper seizure list duly signed by the accompanied Police persons as there was no availability of any local person, as such I could not collect the signature of the local people in seizure list during seizure. I have taken 02 Kg coal from the Pick Up Van as sample after preparing proper level. The seizure was made between 15.25 to 15.45 hrs. I also arrested the above noted accused person at 15.55 hrs after maintaining all formalities regarding arrest. Informed him the ground of arrest and issued Memo of Arrest. After that we made a proper arrangement and brought the arrested accused and seized vehicle loaded with coal at PS for custody.

Therefore, I pray before you that a specific case may kindly be registered against the driver namely Sk Raju (32 Yrs) S/o- Lt. Sk Anwar of J.K. College Road, Police Line, Purulia, Ward No.- 15, PS- Purulia (T), Dist- Purulia and the owner of the seized vehicle Pick Up Van having registration No- JH 09AN 6511 under proper section of law.
