Sub : Prayer for lodging FIR against accused Fakir Banerjee (47Y), S/O Lt. Dayamoy Banerjee of Kanki Bazar, PS-Santaldih Dist- Purulia, U/S 46 A (c) Bengal Excise Act, 1909.

Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused person named as Fakir Banerjee (47Y), S/O Lt. Dayamoy Banerjee of Kanki Bazar, PS-Santaldih Dist- Purulia along with seizure – list and seized items as described below, I beg to state that today (01.11.2023) at about 18.55 hrs I received a source information to the effect that the I.D. Liquor has been kept at Kanki Bazar under this PS in the house of above noted accused illegally, with an object to sale. I have informed the matter to I.C. Santaldih PS and this refers to Santaldih PS GDE no. 33, dtd. – 01.11.2023 and as per order of I.C Santaldih P.S. I along with force left for Kanki Bazar to workout the information with the govt. supplied kit box containing white cloth, sealing wax, seal, papers, carbons, match box, candles etc. I had been to the house of Fakir Banerjee, S/O Lt. Dayamoy Banerjee of Kanki Bazar, P.S. Santaldih at about 19.15 hours. Seeing police party some unknown persons in front of the house of Fakir Banerjee were fled away. However, I could detain one among of them and asked about his identity. He disclosed his name and identity as noted above and as well as admitted that he kept the I.D. Liquor for selling and he was the owner of the said house. However, I along with said accused started a search inside the house of Fakir Banerjee and found the following item in the said house -

1) Approx 40 (Forty) Liters of ID Liquor in 02 (Two) Jerican each approx 20 Liters.

Out of which 500 ML I.D. Liquor from each Jerican in 02 (Two) bottles taken out from the mother sample as sample packet, labeled and sealed with sealing wax.

I interrogated him about the purpose of the stocking and possessing such I.D. liquor. He replied it was the business of him and he was selling the I.D. liquor to villagers illegally to make profit. On repeated question he told that the persons who fled away were his customers (names of those not known to him). However he could not show any documents/papers in support of the possession as well as sale of the said articles.

As such, I seized the above items as ALAMAT under proper Seizure List between 19.45 hrs and 20.05 hrs & took up 500 ML I.D. Liquor from each Jerican in 02 (Two) bottles as samples, labeled and sealed accordingly.

Since the allegation against him of possessing, as well as selling the I.D. liquor illegally without any valid papers in his house has prima-facie been made out and for the interest of proper investigation, I arrested the above accused at 20.15 hrs accordingly after maintaining all arresting guidelines.

Therefore, I pray before you to start a case under proper section of law against the said accused Fakir Banerjee (47Y), S/O Lt. Dayamoy Banerjee of Kanki Bazar, PS-Santaldih Dist-Purulia.
