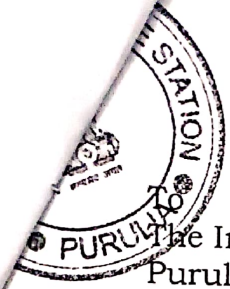

Sub: Prayer for lodging FIR.

Sir,

With due respect I beg to state that; today on (04.01.2024) myself along with these following forces (i) C/- 2505 Anup Kundu & (ii) C/- 768 Ajit Kr. Murmu both of Purulia (M) PS, Dist- Purulia were engaged in special Mobile duty vide Purulia (M) PS GDE No-213 Dtd. 04.01.2024 at about 20.45 hrs. During my special duty I received an information from my source that some people/someone illegally store coal at Khojda Paisatarh under Purulia (M) PS, Dist- Purulia. According to this source of information and as per your guidance and instruction and direction I along with force had been went there to the said place at about **22.05 hrs**. After that as shown by the source we are reached that place i.e. Khojda Paisatarh under G.P Dimdiha, PS- Purulia (M), Dist- Purulia and found that a huge quantity of burned coal is stocking there. But nobody was present there to claim the same coal, except Police personnel. I searched the surrounding area to trace out the owner of said coal, but nobody was found to its ownership.

Made a local enquiry and it is found that an unknown person/persons, stocked the said coal at the above maintained place for selling the same to make own profit by dishonestly and they have been running a clandestine business. On preliminary enquiry it could be learnt that the unknown alleged person/persons procured the said illegal coal from different places and transported the same in a clandestine manner to another district/state. So, it is reasonable to believe that they are transporting the coal illegally after procuring. Accordingly finding no other alternative way I seized approx 08 (Eight) Quintals of burned coal under proper seizure list duly signed by the accompanied Police persons as there was no availability of any local person, as such I could not collect the signature of the local people in all seizure list and during seizure I had taken 02 Kg coal from the stoking coal. The seizure was done in between **22.35 & 22.55 hrs**. After that we made a proper arrangement to bring the coal at PS to keep in PS compound.

Therefore, I pray before you that a specific case may kindly be registered under the proper section of law against the unknown for illegal stocking of coal at above mentioned place.
