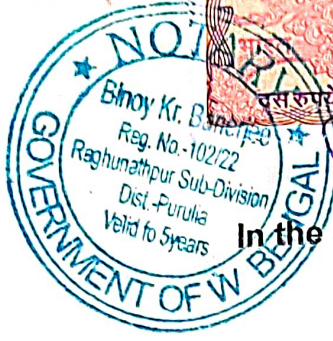

That the Complainant most respectfully beg to state as follows:

1. That the complainant is a permanent resident **Village-Asurbandh, Tola-Tara, P.O.Deoli, P.S. Santaldih, District-Purulia**
2. That the Complainant has been in khas ownership and possession of the Seasonal crops growing lands situated in R.S./L.R Plot numbers. 1548R.S./L.R. Khatian No-594 J.L No-03, of Mouza Amchatar under Police Station-Santaldih within District-Purulia
3. The Complainant like previous years this year also transplanted seasonal crops over the aforesaid agricultural lands,hence thereby the accused persons are became very much covetous.The accused persons since the last part of the month of November trying to reaping seasonal crops by committing theft belonging to the Complainant.
4. That on **23/12/2024** at about 03 p.m. while the complainant usually went to the aforesaid agricultural lands situated in Mouza-Amchatar to look after development of seasonal crops for production transplanted by them found that the accused persons along with their associates have trespassed into the lands in the possession of the complainant and committed **theft** of seasonal crops for an offence Under **Section 379** IPC. In respect of the every lands from which the accused are alleged to have committed **theft** of seasonal crops.When complainant raises objection and shouts a loud then they abuses the complainant with most possible filthy language touches several portion of his body and silenced his with dire consequences.In respect of the every lands from which the accused are alleged to have committed **theft** of seasonal crops.
5. That in the suddenness of the incident the complainant became fully perplexed as well as distracted.Thereafter,While the complainant return back in his house the complainant describe details/entire illegal activities of the accused persons to his other family members they have also amazed and confounded.They decided to go to Santaldih Police Station to lodge FIR against the accused persons.
6. That regarding the above referred facts, the complainant visited the Inspector- in -Charge,Santaldih Police Station with intent to lodge an F.I.R against the said accused persons,but he didn't get any help from him, finally finding no such alternatives, He has intimated a written complaint to the Superintend of Police,Purulia District through registered post on **30.12.2023** and to the Inspector- in -Charge,Santaldih Police Station but still no such action has been taken at yet by the Inspector- in -Charge,Santaldih Police Station.

That the complainant finding no other alternatives, hiseby take the helter of the learned Court with the allegation/averments made hiseinabove, alongwith aforesaid witnesses for the punishment of the accused persons under sections **379/447/ 448/120B /34 IPC** as the police has failed to act in the matter of complaint.

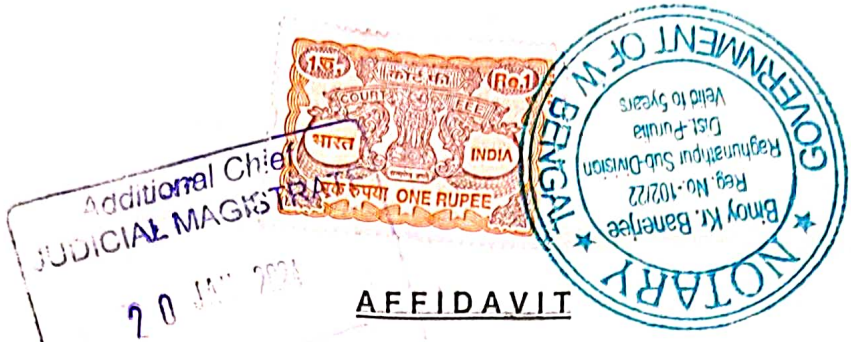
