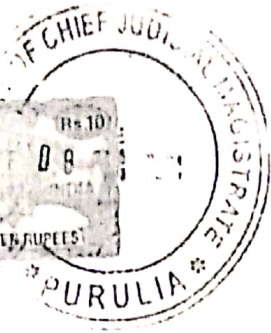
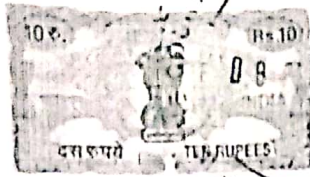

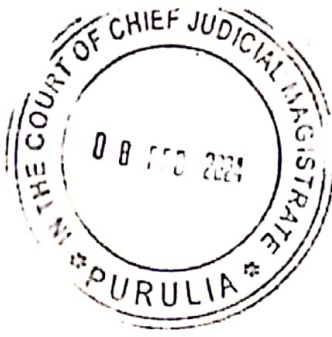

In the matter of a humble complainant on behalf of the complainant:-

Most Respectfully Sheweth:-

1. That, Complainant happens to be the legally married wife of the accused no.1 namely Gopal Paramanik @ Ajoy Paramanik, their marriage was duly solemnised four years ago on 25th Asar 1426 corresponding to Bengali Year calendax (11.07.2019) as per the Hindu Rites and customs prevailing in their society.
2. That the accused person no.1 happens to be the husband of the complainant, accused person no.2 is the father-in-law (Sasur), accused person no.3 is the mother-in-law (Sasuri) and the accused person no.4 is the Brother -in -law (Dayor) of the complainant
3. That at the time of the marriage of the complainant and the accused person no.1, the father of the Petitioner had to give Rs.1,20,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Twenty thousand only), 1 Bhorl Gold and other articles amounting to Rs.1,60,000/-(Rupees One Lakh sixty thousand only) to the accused person as per their demand.
4. That the complainant with a desire to lead a happy conjugal life went to her matrimonial house at Chandil, SaraikeKa Kharson, Jharkhand.
5. That for few days the conjugal life of the complainant was going happily. After 4 months of their marriage the accused person no.1 namely Gopal Paramanik @ Ajoy Paramanik started demanding Rs.10,000/- for purchasing bike and Rs.10,000/- for purchasing a mobile phone. The complainant informed about the demand of her husband to her father wherein the father of the complainant stated it would not be possible for him to fulfil any more demand.
6. That thereafter the accused persons without any fault of the complainant started torturing her, assaulted her with fist and blows, they did not provide food to the complaint on time, they stopped providing the complainant with her basic amenities like clothing and was asked to bring it from her father's house. Like this the accused persons regularly tortured the complainant both mentally and physically.

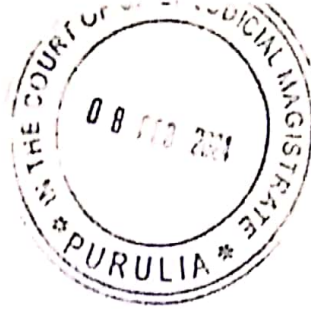

7. That the complainant instead of being treated as daughter in law was treated as a made in her matrimonial house. Tolerating the torture the complainant for the sake of her conjugal life stayed at her matrimonial house.
8. That the complainant have a female child who is aged about 2 years, the second time she got pregnant and at the matured stage of her pregnancy when she got labor pain no initiative was taken by the accused persons to take her for treatment. Taking other person's mobile phone the complainant informed everything to her father, her father and mother on 08.08.2023 at night at about 11 p.m reached her matrimonial house wherein they were insulted, the accused person no. 1 threw the complainant out of his house caught holding by her neck.
9. That the parents of the complainant on 09.08.2023 morning at about 5 a.m admitted the complainant to Pathardih BPHC wherein on that date she gave birth to a male child.
10. That at present the complainant is staying at her father's house along with her children, since she was thrown out of her matrimonial house none of the accused persons ever enquired about the wellbeing or whereabouts of the complainant or her children.
11. That the complainant went to the Baghmundi Police Station to lodge her complaint but the authority concerned did not entertain the complaint of the complainant so she had to send her complaint to the Baghmundi Police Station via registered post addressing the Officer -In- Charge, Baghmundi Police Station on 02.01.2024 which reached there on 03.01.2024 but the Officer in charge has not taken any action relating to the complainant.
12. That later getting no other alternative the matter has been informed in writing to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia and was send to his office vide registered post on 17.01.2024 which reached his office on 18.01.2024 but till date no legal initiatives has been taken by the Office concerned hence the complainant had no other alternative but to approach before the Ld. Court of Law to file this petition praying for taking necessary action against the accused persons who has committed illegalities against her.

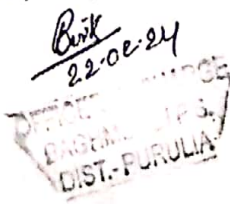

- 13. That, proper Police investigation should be taken up by treating this complaint as F.I.R and action should be taken against the accused persons as per Law for the Interest of Justice.

That, as Officer In Charge Baghmundih Police Station, Purulia in spite of getting specific information / complaint from the complaint has not instituted any F.I.R against the accused persons nor any initiative has been taken from the Office of the Superintendent of Police, Purulia, let this complaint be forwarded to the Officer- in – Charge Baghmundih Police Station, Purulia for treating the same as F.I.R and for undertaking investigation.
- 15. That as required all the formalities of Lodging Complain U/S- 154 Cr.P.C, U/S- 154(3) Cr.P.Code has duly been complied with by the complainant. But yet no F.I.R has been lodged against the accused person.
