Respected Sir,

In producing here with one arrested accused person Kalipada Paramanik (55 yrs) S/O- Lt. Mangal Paramanik of Vill- Rangadih Hemal Para, P.S-Balarampur, Dist. Purulia along with seized 12 bottles country sprit style as 'DIL SE' each bottle containing 600 ml (MRF each Rs-55/-) (details of seized articles are mentioned in attached seizure list), to the effect that today on 09.02.2024 I SI Chanchal Acharya along with C/3301 Md. Manan Ansary & C/3381 Prasanta Sahis was engaged in mobile duty vide Balarampur PS CC No- 772/2024 dt-09.02.2024. In course of mobile duty at about 17:05 hrs. I received a telephonic information from a reliable source that one person have stocked some illicit liquor at his own house at Rangadih Hemal Para under Balarampur P.S & selling the same to innocent people for his personal gain. Accordingly, I informed to O/C Balarampur P.S. regarding this matter and as per his direction I along with force left for Rangadih Hemal Para village to work out this information. Thereafter as per source at 17:25 hrs we reached at Rangadih Hemal Para village, I along with force held raid in the house of Kalipada Paramanik.

During search with the help of accompany with force, we found that the said person is selling ID liquor at his respective house at Rangadih Hemal Para village. On demand, he failed to produce any valid documents or valid License in respect of selling and keeping of said ID liquor. Accordingly, I seized the following articles from the possession of accused person as follows- 12 bottle country sprit style as 'DIL SE' each bottle containing 600 ml (MRF each Rs-55/-) after preparing proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses and labelled. I arrested him after preparing proper arrest memo as he committed offence U/S 46A(c) B.E. Act 1909 after maintaining all the formalities as per NHRC guide line.

Under the above circumstances and fact, I therefore pray that a cog case may kindly be started U/S 46A(c) B.E. Act against the arrested accused person Kalipada Paramanik (55 yrs) S/O- Lt. Mangal Paramanik of Vill- Rangadih Hemal Para, P.S-Balarampur, Dist. Purulia to start a cog case U/S 46A(c) B.E. Act and arrange for its investigation.
