Sub: Prayer to start a specific case under proper section of law.

Sir,

In producing here with seized vehicle (TATA CE) bearing registration no- WB55/5452 loaded with approx-60 cft. sand along with seizure list.

I beg to state that I received information that illegal lifting of sand from the river bed of Kumari river near Purihansa village under Bansbera G.P. I communicated the matter to I.C Barabazar PS and as per direction myself along with C/- 677 Syed Julhar Ali, C/- 897 Umapada Dhalla left PS to verify the information and holding raid at Bansbera G.P area vide Barabazar PS GDE No- 710 Dtd. 13.02.2024 and C.C No- 697/24 Dtd. 13.02.2024 with Govt vehicle. I was carrying a normal investigation kit box with me.

Around 13.45 hrs we reached to the spot and Kept the vehicle at far distance and proceed to reach the place as identified by the source by foot and Seeing the Police party, the driver of the said sand loaded vehicle fled away. After a hot chase we could not able to apprehend him. We found one white colour Tempo Van (TATA/CE) bearing registration no- WB55/5452 loaded with approx. 60 (Sixty) cft. Sand is standing beside the road side river. We tried to collect some local witnesses at that time none could be found. Then, I seized the said sand loaded vehicle after furnishing proper seizure list and duly signed by the police witnesses. Also 500 gm. Sand seized from which as sample. The seizure was made in between 14.05 Hrs to 14.25 Hrs.

So far information collected it is crystal clear that often the driver and the owner of this vehicle lifting sand by illegal means from the river bed of Kumari river with intent to make unlawful profit through illegal manner by unauthorized lifting of minerals.

By this way they committed the theft of minerals. As such there is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the said vehicle with ill motive were transporting the sand illegally. As such they were doing illegal business activities.

After returning at PS, I typed this complaint and submitted it before I/C Barabazar PS for starting a specific case under proper section of law and also pray for arrange its investigation.
