Sir,

In producing here with the arrested accused person namely Ranjit Mahato (30 yrs) S/o Sitaram Mahato of Vill-Purihasa, PS-Barabazar, Dist-Purulia driver of Dumper having registration No- WB55A-7455 and brought under seizure 01 Dumper having Reg. No WB55A-7455 loaded with approx 20 (twenty) Ton stone under proper seizure list.

I beg to state that during mobile duty at PS area along with C/1182 Santosh Kr. Mahato & C/897 Umapada Dhalla both are of Barabazar PS left PS to verify the information and holding raid at Bansbera G.P. area vide Barabazar PS GDE No- 1210 Dtd. 21.02.2024 and C.C No- 793/24 Dtd. 21.02.2024 with Govt vehicle received a source information that illegal excavation of stone is going on under the Bansbera G.P at Sargo Morh. I communicated the matter to I.C Barabazar PS and as per direction myself along with accompany force left for Sargo Morh to work out the information. Reached at about 18:35 hrs near beside Srgo Morh, kept the vehicle in at a distance and proceed to reach the place as identified by the source by foot. As per information and as shown by source we reached at Sargo Morh and found 01 Dumper is lying by the side loaded with stone chips. We rushed there and detained it.

Seeing the Police party some persons fled away. After a hot chase we managed to apprehend one person. Then we searched the area and found 01 Dumper loaded with stone approx 20 (twenty) Ton. On interrogation the apprehended person disclosed his identity as noted above. I asked him to produce any valid documents in r/o excavated stone which is loaded in Dumper and whether he has any permission for chips stone but he failed to produce any valid document for excavation of stone. He along with the Dumper's owner and others is doing this illegal act of stone excavation.

Accordingly, I seized the above noted vehicle (Dumper) /stone under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses. After that I arrested the accused driver as noted above after maintaining all formalities regarding arrest. I also informed him regarding the grounds of arrest and informed his relative.

Held an enquiry about the matter and so far information collected it is crystal clear that the driver and the owner of the vehicle (Dumper) having Reg. No WB55A-7455 collected the stone by illegal means with intend to make unlawful profit by unlawful collection of stone through illegal manner by unauthorized extraction and removal of minerals.

By this way they committed the theft of minerals. As such there is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the Dumper with ill motive were transporting the stone illegally without any valid document in support of carrying the stone. As such they were doing illegal business activities.

It consumed some time and some delay was occurred to return at PS. After returning at PS, I prepared this letter of complaint and handing over it to I.C Barabazar PS for starting a case under proper section of law.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I pray before you that kindly take needful action against the driver & owner of the Dumper responsible for illegal mining of minerals.
