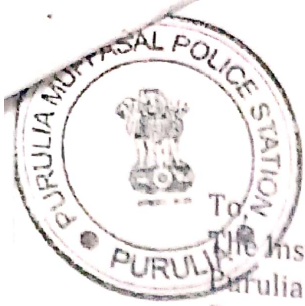

Sub: Prayer for lodging FIR under proper section of law.

Sir,

In producing herewith the seized vehicle (Tractor) having Reg. No- JH 09AS 4870 attached with Trolley, loaded with sand approx 100 cft and Seizure list.

I beg to state that today (26.02.2024) myself along with force (i) C/- 2078 Haripada Das & (ii) C/- 178 Tulsi Mahato both of Purulia (M) PS left for mobile duty vide Purulia (M) PS GDE No- 1427 Dtd. 26.02.2024 at PS area. At about 06:45 hrs, I received information from a source that two suspicious tractors loaded with sand were coming from Kantabera Ghat (Kasai River). Accordingly, I informed the matter to you and as per your kind directions, I along with force proceeded towards that place to work out the information. While I, along with the force, arrived at Kantabera Ghat near bricks field area under Purulia (M) PS at about 07:00 hrs we found one Tractor attached with a trolley loaded with sand standing at that place and seeing the Police Party one tractor having Registration No- WB 55A 8010 fled away from there. Accordingly, I along with the force intercepted one vehicle (Tractor) having Reg. No- JH 09AS 4870 attached with Trolley, loaded with sand approx 100 cft without a driver or any other person. I found that the vehicles as well as goods were identical as I received prior information. I moved through the surrounding area to trace the said driver or owner of said detained tractor as well as another tractor, but nobody was found to stand its ownership. During primary enquiry it was found that the owners and drivers of the said vehicles (Tractor) loaded the said sand by illegal means to sell the same to make their own profit by dishonestly and they had been running a clandestine business. It is reasoned to believe that the driver in cahoots with the owner of the vehicles and others procured the said sand from the Kansai River under Purulia (M) PS side by fraudulent means or theft by any means to transport the same to run a clandestine business.

Accordingly, finding no other alternative way I seized the one Tractor having Reg. No- JH 09AS 4870 attached with Trolley, loaded with sand approx 100 cft under proper seizure list. The seizure was made in between 07.05 & 07.25 hrs in presence of the available witnesses duly signed by them. Thereafter, I brought the said seized Tractor (vehicle) having Reg. No- JH 09AS 4870 to Purulia (M) PS compound for safe custody.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I therefore, pray before you that kindly take lawful action against the owners and drivers of the seized vehicle (Tractors) having Reg. No- JH 09AS 4870 attached with Trolley, loaded with sand approx 100 cft and another tractor having Registration No- WB 55A 8010 under proper section of Law.
