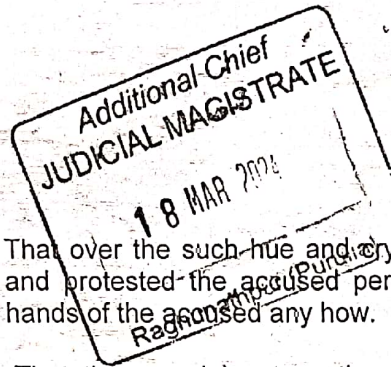

That the complainant most respectfully beg to state as follows:-

- that the complainant is the resident of village+P.O.+P.S.- Adra, Dist.- Purulia, W.B. and the incident took place within the jurisdiction of your Id. Court
- the complainant on 28/01/2024 at about 9.30 P.M., when the son of the complainant namely Aditya Kumar Verma returned home by his motor-cycle, then on and sudden, the accused person namely Abhishek Kumar, Ayush Kumar & Suman Abhishek Kumar came out from their residence and without informing or asking anything to said Aditya Kumar Verma, in furtherance of common intention, assaulted him with fist and blows in the matter of writing something bad over the dusted seat of their motor-cycle and also abused him with filthy language and threaten him to kill.
- That said Aditya kumar verma tried his best to save himself from the hands of accused persons by saving himself from the assault but failed as the above named accused persons are overpower and finding no other alternative, he raised his voice to save from accused person, and over the helping call of said Aditya Kumar Verma, the witness no. 2, being the mother, came out from her house and tried to save her son, but the above named accused persons pulled her heirs and assaulted her also.

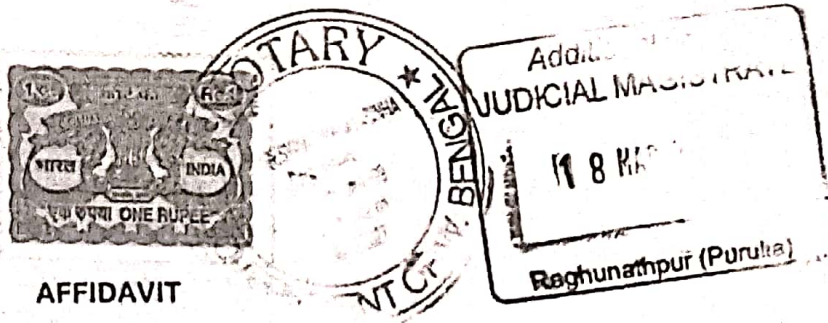

7. That finding no other alternative the present complainant took the shelter of the Id. court for the redressal of her grievance.

It is therefore prayed before the Id. Court may kindly allow this petition treating the same U/S 156(3) of Cr.P.C. , and to pass necessary order/orders , direction/directions, to the Inspector In Charge, Adra Police Station to treat the same as F.I.R. against the above named accused persons and any other order/orders, direction/directions , as your Id. Court may deem fit and proper for the ends of Justice, And for this act of kindness the complainant shall ever prays.


