An Application on behalf of the
Petitioner/Complainant,

Most Respectfully Sheweth:-

1. That the complainant is the permanent resident of village - Kesargarh, PO - Rakab, PS - Hura, Dist. - Purulia and the accused person also residing at same village area of village - Kesargarh, PO - Rakab, PS - Hura, Dist. - Purulia and co-villagers of the complainant.
2. That the accused lady approached the complainant with false assurance and with a view to cause fraud upon him that she is like to sell her four wheeler bearing Regd. No - 55B - 1907 (Mahindra Supro) and total consideration amount was fixed at price of Rs. 80,000/- and the complainant also paid total 16 EMIs of Rs. 11700, per EMI, per month.
3. That accordingly, on 15.07.2022 an agreement was made in between complainant and the accused at Purulia Court and the same was notarized. It is pertinent to mention at this juncture that the complainant had paid Rs. 80,000/- to the accused lady on

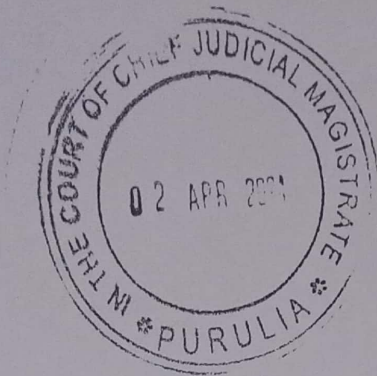

- 15.07.2022 at the time of execution of agreement deed which has been mentioned in the agreement.
4. That as per terms, the complainant had paid total EMIs of Rs. 11700/- per month.
 5. That after completion of all accrued EMIs, when the complainant asked the accused to hand over the vehicle, the latter refused to hand over the same and started threatening the complainant.
 6. That on 20.02.2023, as per agreement, when the complainant again approached the accused to hand over the ownership of the vehicle, the accused abused the complainant with most filthy languages and threatened the complainant that the accused would implicate the complainant in false criminal case if the complainant asked for transfer of ownership of the vehicle in question any further.
 7. That ultimately, sometimes in the month of February, 2024, when the complainant again requested the accused that he paid all the accrued EMIs of the vehicle as per agreement. The complainant again requested the accused with folded hands that if the accused would not transfer the ownership then refund the amount which he invested as per terms of the accused, at that time, the accused gave out that she would transfer the ownership only if the complainant paid additional cash of Rs. 30,000/- to her, otherwise she would not transfer the ownership.
 8. That by such act of commission, the accused cheated the complainant under misrepresentation and wrongfully gain from the accused.

9. That the complainant on 21.02.2024 informed the matter to the O/C Hura PS by submitted written complainant against the misdeeds of the complainant and on being non action by the side of the Hura PS, the complainant sent his written complaint to the SP, Purulia on 08.03.2024.
10. That after giving sufficient knowledge to the O/C Hura PS and SP, Purulia, the complainant again on 21.03.2024 sent his written complainant to the O/C, Hura PS through speed post of Indian Post against the accused lady but till date no specific case has yet been started.
11. That search and seizure is very much warranted in the instant case and your petitioner is a very poor and heaving no such income for incurring expenses of a complaint case.
12. That the complainant has complied with all the provisions as per guidelines of our Hon'ble Apex Court, India i.e. served the knowledge of commission of cognizable offences to the S.P. as well as the police authority concerned but specific investigation has not been start.
13. That the complainant has able to make out the prima facie case which shows the commission of cognizable offences by the accused persons and the accused persons are till now threatened the complainant with dire consequences.
