Respected sir,

In producing herewith the 01 (One) seized truck (Haiva) having registration no. WB81/1995 loaded with approx 700 cft sand and also produced Seizure list. The fact in brief is that today (16.04.2024) I along with force namely C/1183 Subhas Kundu & C/948 Ramen Pramanick were performing night mobile duty in IC BCW area vide Santaldih IC BCW GDE No- 302 Dated- 16.04.2024 in c/w Santaldih IC BCW CC No- 669/24 Dated- 16.04.2024. During my night mobile patrolling duty, when I along with force were going to Ushir village, near Ushir Daspara under this PS we saw one truck (Haiva) having registration no. WB81/1995 carrying overloaded sand coming from Chelyama side & was going towards Kamargora village side. Subsequently, we intercepted the said truck near Daspara, Ushir village at about 00:40 hrs. We also detained the driver of truck (Haiva) having registration no. WB81/1995. Being asked the driver of the truck stated that his name i.e Parimal Kumbhakar, S/O Shaktipada Kumbhakar of Vill. - Baragoria, PS - Raghunathpur, Dist. - Purulia and he also stated that he loaded the said sand from Saltora, Bankura and the paper of the said sand lying before the owner of the vehicle. We waited reasonable time but none came to the spot to produce any documents. Accordingly, I, seized the truck (Haiva) having registration no. WB81/1995 loaded with approx 700 cft sand under proper seizure list in presence of the driver and available witnesses duly signed by them in between 00.55 hrs to 01.15 hrs. During enquiry, it is ascertain that the driver of the said truck (Haiva) having registration no. WB81/1995 loaded the said sand in cahoots with the owner of the vehicle by illegal means for selling the same to make profit by dishonestly and they had been running a clandestine business by transporting the same at Jharkhand State. So, it is reason to believe that they in cahoots with the owner of the vehicle procured the said sand by fraudulently means or theft by any means for transporting the same at Jharkhand State to run clandestine business. So, I, arrested the above noted accused driver observing all arresting guidelines on 16.04.2024 at 01.25 hrs. During interrogation he also confessed his guilt in this case. Thereafter, I brought the said truck (Haiva) and driver to Santaldih PS compound.

Under above fact and circumstances, I, pray before you to start a specific case against the above noted driver namely Parimal Kumbhakar, S/O Shaktipada Kumbhakar of Vill. - Baragoria, PS - Raghunathpur, Dist. - Purulia and the owner of the above noted truck (Haiva) having registration no. WB81/1995 under proper sections of law.
