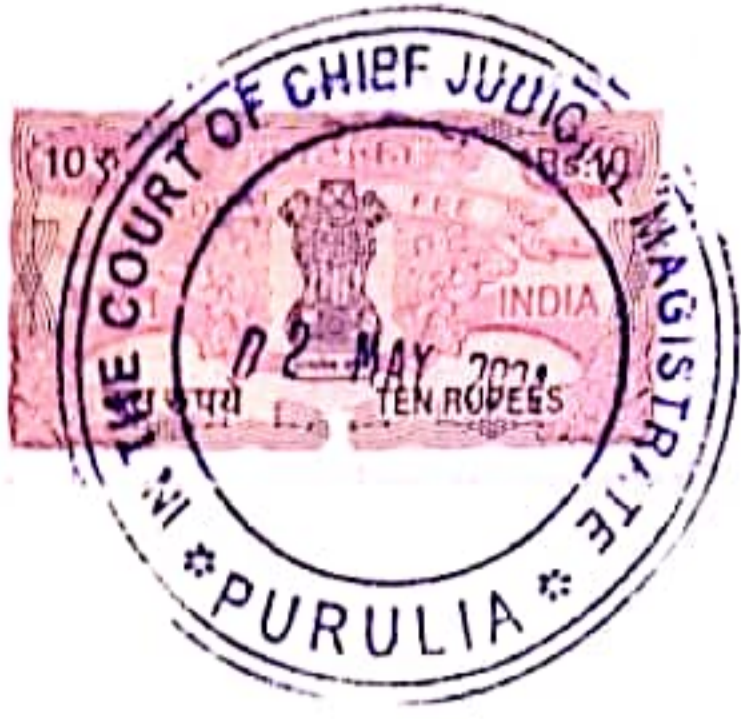

The above name complainant begs to state as follows:

- 1) That the complainant is the legally married wife of the accused no-1 Parikhit Mahato and their marriage was solemnized on 03/06/2023 corresponding to 19th Jaistha-1430 B.S. as per Hindu rites and customs as prevalent in their community and also by observing the formalities like putting on vermilion,

exchange of garlands, Home etc. and the said marriage is still subsisting.

- 2) That at the time of marriage as per demand of the accused persons father of the complainant had to pay a cash of Rs. 1,50,000/-, golden and silver ornament weighing of 3 bhories, and silver ornament along with furniture and utensils including various type of articles.
- 3) That after marriage the complainant was taken at her matrimonial house and started to reside with Parikhit Mahato i.e. the accused no-1 as husband and wife along with other inmates of the family with a hope locked in to her heart for her future prospects at her matrimonial relationship and life with her husband Parikhit Mahato. But, the complainant noticed that all the above noted accused persons somehow avoided the complainant in all respect.

However, the complainant did not take it to be the natural thinking on the part of the accused persons considering that everything would be normal after passage of time. But the

above noted accused persons without any reasons started all sorts of inhuman both physical as well as mental torture upon the complainant which increased day by day, when it was unbearable for the complainant, then the complainant protested and put question to them i.e. the accused persons as to why they ill behaved with the complainant, and in such circumstance then the accused persons became very angry and started to abuse the complainant in filthy languages and used to assault her and also did not provided her proper food and clothing and also driven her out occasionally from her matrimonial house.

- 4) That when such state of thing was going on they put pressure upon the complainant to bring Rs. 1,00,000/- as further dowry from her father's house as the cash and kinds given at the time of marriage was very much insufficient. When such illegal demand was not fulfilled then the accused persons asked the complainant to leave their house and to commit suicide so that

they could arrange second marriage of the accused no-1 i.e. the husband of the complainant.

For the purpose of second marriage of the accused no-1 i.e. the husband of the complainant actually searching for a girl in presence of the complainant.

- 5) That Thereafter, on 04/01/2024 corresponding to 18th Poush 1430 B.S. all the above noted accused persons assaulted the complainant mercilessly and driven her out from their house by giving out that unless her father paid a cash of Rs. 1,00,000/- to the accused persons, they will not allow the complainant to stay in their house for resuming their conjugal life, but to kill her by putting fire.
- 6) That since thereafter, the complainant is residing at her paternal house, but neither the accused no-1 i.e. the husband of the complainant nor any of the above noted accused persons taken any information for the complainant nor they arrange to bring her back in her matrimonial house for resuming their conjugal life.

- 7) That the accused persons committed various offences punishable under the Indian penal code for which they are deserved to be punished under the law.
- 8) That the matter was reported to the Officer-in-charge Barabazar P.S. against the accused persons but the said Officer-in-charge did not taken any legal action then the complainant lodged another complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia but with same fate, then the complainant is under compelling circumstances is filing this complaint before the Ld. Court for appropriate reliefs under the law.

It is therefore, prayed that your honour may be pleased to sent the petition of complaint to the Officer-in-charge Barabazar P.S. for treating the same as FIR under section 156(3) for investigation .
