Sub: Request for lodging FIR against Unknown miscreants.

Sir,

I, SI Bharat Mandi of Baghmundi PS do hereby lodged suomoto typed complaint to the effect that on 18.06.2024 at about 11:05 hrs one male unknown decomposed dead body aged approx 50 yrs has been recovered from Jahirabad under Serengdih Mouza, PS- Baghmundi, Dist-Purulia in cultivated land of one Parikshit Gorai, S/O-Lt-Gokul Ch. Gorai of Vill-Serengdih, PS- Baghmundi, Dist-Purulia as per information of Parikshit Gorai. Over this information started Baghmundi PS U/D Case No- 30/2024, Dtd. 18.06.2024. As per endorsement I, SI Bharat Mandi along with UD C/1471 Sankar Ruhidas of Baghmundi PS went to the spot and found that one unknown decomposed male dead body aged approx 50 years lying at Jahirabad under Serengdih Mouza, PS- Baghmundi, Dist-Purulia in cultivated land of Parikshit Gorai, S/O-Lt-Gokul Gorai of Vill-Serengdih, PS- Baghmundi, Dist-Purulia. I seized (i) একটি সাদা রঙ্গের ধুতি, (ii) একটি লাল রঙ্গের চেক গামছা from the PO and preparing proper seizure list duly sign by local witnesses. Hold surathal report over the unknown decomposed dead body. During surathal in open eyes as the dead body was decomposed, hence it is not sure that the death was homicidal in nature or not. There after I arranged to send the unknown male decomposed dead body to Purulia Deben Mahato Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Purulia through escort C/1471 Sankar Ruhidas for PM examination to ascertain actual cause of death.

On 19.06.2024 I collected PM report of unknown male decomposed dead body vide PM No- 655/2024 Dtd. 18/06/2024 in which Autopsy Surgeon Dr. Parag Baran Pal, Professor & H.O.D, Department of Forensic Medicine & Toxicology, Deben Mahato Govt. Medical College & Hospital Purulia opined that **“Death was due to the effects of manual strangulation (throttling) ante mortem and homicidal in nature”**.

As the cause of death is due to the effects of manual strangulation (throttling) ante mortem and homicidal in nature, So, I am submitting this complaint against unknown miscreants for starting a specific case under proper section of law and also arrange for its investigation.
