Sub: Prayer for lodging FIR under proper section of law.

Sir,

In producing herewith the arrested accused driver namely 1) Krishnapada Mahato (24 Yrs), S/o Shaktipada Mahato of Vill- Sarberia, PS- Para, Dist- Purulia 2) Mustak Ansari (35 Yrs), S/o Ramjan Ansari of Vill- Lipania, PS- Para, Dist- Purulia along with 02 (two) seized Tractor bearing Reg. No- WB81-1974 and WB55B-6468, attached with trolley loaded with sand approx 100 cft each, Seizure list and Memo of Arrest.

I beg to state that today (10.07.2024) I, SI Mekdam Sabab along with ASI Khageswar Kumar and force (i) C/1182 Santosh Kr. Mahato (ii) C/1494 Manas Mukherjee of Purulia (M) PS left the PS for performing mobile duty vide Purulia (M) PS GDE No- 820, Dtd. 10.07.2024 in PS area. During my mobile duty, I received a tip off at 10.25 hrs. that 02 (two) suspicious tractors loaded with sand were coming from Surulia Bauri Para Kacha Road towards Gopalpur- Palaskola village road. Subsequently, I along with officer and force proceeded towards Surulia village to work out the tip off. While I along with the force arrived at opposite Surulia Mini Zoo, Village Surulia under Purulia (M) PS, we found that 02 (two) tractors were proceeding towards Gopalpur- Palaskola village road coming from Surulia Bauri Para Kacha Road. Accordingly, I along with the force intercepted those 02 (two) Tractors bearing Reg. No- WB81-1974 and WB55B-6468, attached with trolley loaded with sand approx 100 cft each at about 11:05 hrs and detained 02 (two) persons who were driving the said tractors. I found that the vehicles as well as goods was identical as I received prior information. On being asked, the drivers of the Tractors disclosed their name as 1) Krishnapada Mahato (24 Yrs), S/o Shaktipada Mahato of Vill- Sarberia, PS- Para, Dist- Purulia 2) Mustak Ansari (35 Yrs), S/o Ramjan Ansari of Vill- Lipania, PS- Para, Dist- Purulia and also stated that they are the driver of said Tractors. I asked the drivers of the Tractors to produce the valid documents in respect of the Tractors as well as the loaded sand. But both the driver of the said Tractors were not able to produce any kind of documents in respect of Tractors and the sand. I repeatedly asked them to produce the valid paper but they stated differently at different times. The incoherent statement of the drivers purported to be suspicious to us. It was ascertained that the drivers of the tractors loaded the said sand in cahoots with the owner of the Tractor by illegal means for selling the same to make their own profit by dishonestly and they had been running a clandestine business. So it is reasoned to believe that the alleged driver in cahoots with the owners of the Tractors procured the said sand from Pithajore Dam by fraudulently or theft by any means for transporting the same to run clandestine business. So I seized 02 (two) Tractors bearing Reg. No- WB81-1974, attached with trolley loaded with sand approx 100 cft from the possession of Krishnapada Mahato (24 Yrs), S/o Shaktipada Mahato of Vill- Sarberia, PS- Para, Dist- Purulia and the



tractor bearing Reg. NO. WB55B-6468, attached with trolley loaded with sand approx 100 cft from the possession of Mustak Ansari (35 Yrs), S/o Ramjan Ansari of Vill- Lipania, PS- Para, Dist- Purulia, under proper seizure list in presence of available witnesses duly signed by them. The seizure was done at 16.15 hrs.

Also arrested the alleged drivers namely 1) Krishnapada Mahato (24 Yrs), S/o Shaktipada Mahato of Vill- Sarberia, PS- Para, Dist- Purulia 2) Mustak Ansari (35 Yrs), S/o Ramjan Ansari of Vill- Lipania, PS- Para, Dist- Purulia after informing the ground of their arrest and issued Memo of Arrest against them and also issued Check List. The arrest was completed at 11:35 hrs. Thereafter, I brought the seized tractors and alleged arrested drivers to Purulia (M) PS.

Under the above facts and circumstances, I therefore, pray you kindly take lawful action against the owners of seized Tractors bearing Reg. No- WB81-1974 and WB55B-6468, attached with trolley loaded with sand approx 100 cft each and the arrested drivers namely 1) Krishnapada Mahato (24 Yrs), S/o Shaktipada Mahato of Vill- Sarberia, PS- Para, Dist- Purulia 2) Mustak Ansari (35 Yrs), S/o Ramjan Ansari of Vill- Lipania, PS- Para, Dist- Purulia under proper section of Law.
