Sir,

I, SI Sanjoy Kr. Das of Arsha P.S. do hereby lodge a complaint *in suo-moto* against 1. Sanjit Kumar Mondal & Late Khayendramath Mondal of Vill (PO)- Sirkabad, P.S.-Arsha, Dist-Purulia owner cum Head Master of Vidya Bharati School Sirkabad, 2. Driver & owner of seized Tata ACE bearing Reg. No. WB55B/1994 and 3. The Distributor/owner of Raghupur Indane Gramin Vitarak (supplier) along with the seized articles i.e. (i) 13 (Thirteen) pieces empty LPG domestic Gas cylinder of Indane company (14.2 Kg capacity) (ii) one white colour Tata ACE vehicle bearing Reg. No. WB55B/1994, (iii) 56 (Fifty six) pieces fully loaded domestic LPG Gas cylinders of Indane company in sealed condition and (iv) 13 (Thirteen) pieces of Gas booking Passbook.

To the effect that today on 22.08.2024 morning O/C, Arsha P.S. received credible information from unknown that an illegal stocking of domestic LPG cylinder and also re-filling and selling of small Gas cylinder (of 1kg) from the 14Kg cylinder is being done at the premises of Vidya Bharati Private School at Sirkabad under Arsha P.S. since past few months. The information was noted vide Arsha P.S. GDE No. 1004 dated 22.08.2024 and as per direction of O/C, Arsha P.S., I SI Sanjoy Kumar Das along with day mobile police party C/924 Aswini Kumar Pandey of Arsha P.S. and C/191 Faruk Ansary of SAP 7th BN camp at Arsha P.S. had been to Sirkabad village to work out the information. We reached at Vidya Bharati School, Sirkabad under Arsha P.S. at about 10.45 hrs and entered the premises. On searching we found huge nos. of domestic empty & full (Sealed) LPG cylinders kept inside the school premises and also found one white colour Tata ACE bearing Reg. No. WB55B/1994 in the school premises where some domestic gas cylinders were being unloaded. Seeing the police party all fled away, I along with force searched everywhere but the apparatus for re-filling could not be traced out. I tried to find out the owner cum head Master of Vidya Bharati School and owner of Tata ACE bearing Reg. No. WB55B/1994 for collecting valid document/license in respect of stocking, distribution & selling of LPG of cylinder but nothing was found. I contacted with local witnesses including teachers of the school and it was revealed that the owner cum Head Master Sanjit Kumar Mondal, the dealer of Raghupur Indane Gramin Vitarak (supplier) and the owner of Tata ACE bearing Reg. No. WB55B/1994 are running this illegal business since last few months. Accordingly, I seized the above noted articles with above vehicle in between 11.05 hrs to 11.35 hrs, with proper seizure list (enclosed) and labeled in presence of local witnesses observing all formalities relating to search and seizure. The Audio & Videography of entire processes of search and seizure has been done. The videography has been stored in memory card which is enclosed here with.

I therefore, pray before you that as the premises of a school is being used illegally for stocking, distribution & selling of LPG, the offence is liable for prosecution U/S 287/3(5) of the BNS & 3/7 of the Essential commodities Act and FIR may be lodged against the above noted persons for investigation.
