Sub:- Complaint against Mayur Singh Sardar (37 yrs) S/O- Bhajahari Singh Sardar of Vill-Beradih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist. Purulia to start a specific case U/S 46A(c) B.E. Act of 1909.

Respected Sir,

In producing here with one arrested accused person Mayur Singh Sardar (37 yrs) S/O- Bhajahari Singh Sardar of Vill-Beradih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist. Purulia along with seized approx 10 (Ten) litres ID liquor in one plastic jarican (details of seized articles are mentioned in attached seizure list), to the effect that today i.e. on 25.08.2024, I ASI Subhas Ch. Kaibarta along with C/202 Dibakar Hansda, C/3396 Mamtaj Ansary all of Balarampur PS, Purulia was engaged in Evening Mobile duty vide Balarampur PS CC No- 2636/2024 dt- 25.08.2024. In course of Evening mobile duty at about 20:25 hrs. I have received an information from a reliable source that one person has stored some illicit liquor at Bandih morh near Masirbari under Balarampur P.S & selling the same to innocent people for his personal gain. Accordingly, I informed to O/C Balarampur P.S. regarding this matter and as per his direction I along with force left for Bandih morh near Masirbari to work out this information. At about 20:55 hrs I along with force reached at Bandih morh near Masirbari and contacted with my source. From a reasonable distance my source has identified the place where the ID liquor has stored illegally. I along with force held raid and found that one person is selling ID liquor which is stored in a jarican. On seeing the Police party the person has tried to flee but I along with force apprehend the person. On asking the apprehended person disclosed his name as Mayur Singh Sardar (37 yrs) S/O- Bhajahari Singh Sardar of Vill-Beradih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist. Purulia. On interrogation he confessed that he is selling the ID liquor in lieu of money for his personnel gain.

Myself along with force and the apprehended person search the place and found that he has stored ID liquor in a plastic jarican about 10 litres. On demand, he failed to produce any valid documents or valid License in respect of selling and keeping of said ID liquor. Accordingly, I seized 10 litters of ID liquor in a white plastic jarican from the possession of accused person after preparing proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses and the accused person. I also took 500 ML (Approx) ID liquor as sample in a plastic bottle from the mother container and sealed & labelled all the articles on the spot. The seizure procedure was done in between 21:05 hrs to 21:25 hrs. Then I arrested Mayur Singh Sardar (37 yrs) S/O- Bhajahari Singh Sardar of Vill-Beradih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist. Purulia after preparing proper arrest memo as he committed offence U/S 46A(c) B.E. Act 1909 after maintaining all the formalities as per NHRC guide line.

The Audio & Videography of entire processes of search and seizure has been done. The videography has been stored in memory card which is enclosed here with.

Under the above circumstances, I therefore pray that a specific case may kindly be started U/S 46A(c) B.E. Act against the arrested accused person Mayur Singh Sardar (37 yrs) S/O- Bhajahari Singh Sardar of Vill-Beradih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist. Purulia and arrange for its investigation.
