Sub: Vandalism in the Office of the undersigned is to be notified as an FIR

Sir,

One Dilip Bouri, S/O Nimai Bouri of Vill: Chinpina, PO & PS: Raghunathpur, Dist: Purulia, was called upon a hearing, as on today for a particular Misc Case, got submitted earlier, being based on his prayer. However, he, beyond this authority's knowledge, in any way, at all, suddenly brought a ferocious mob into the hearing. They came on the hearing table of Md. Sadaab Ehsan, Revenue Officer and unnecessarily started arguing against his logic. After a minute or two, the throng, led by that Dilip Bouri, as well as, supported by one Tarak Bouri endlessly started using cumulative abusive expletives, towards the Revenue Officers, present there, namely Satyajit Mukherjee, Debasis Maity and Manas Chakraborty. Later in my presence they attacked on the desk and damaged a light and a desktop, that, indeed are the government properties. Due to the destructive chaos, created and the augmented vandalism, the hearing of the other cases, scheduled for the day have, well been disturbed and the signatory got forced to postpone the other hearings for the day. Their misconduct and wrecking, at the same time, the argot forced the undersigned along with the other Revenue Officers attached to the office of the Block Land & Land Reforms Officer, Raghunathpur – I, Purulia, to postpone the other hearings, duly assigned by the West Bengal Land Reforms Act, 1955, accordingly, to concentrate for pacifying the stained situation. Thus they created an odious hindrance in the way of performing to restrain Government duties & responsibilities in the office.

Hence the undersigned sends this letter, which may be treated as an FIR, for taking necessary action(s) in this regard.
