Sub:- Complaint against Mansa Gorai (approx 45 years) S/O- Bhim Gorai of Vill-Rangadih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist. Purulia to start a specific case U/S 46A(c) B.E. Act of 1909.

Respected Sir,

In producing here with one arrested accused person Mansa Gorai (approx 45 years) S/O- Bhim Gorai of Vill-Rangadih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist. Purulia along with seized approx 09 (Nine) litres ID liquor in one plastic jarican (details of seized articles are mentioned in attached seizure list), to the effect that today i.e. on 07.09.2024, I ASI Nimai Rajwar of Balarampur PS along with C/3194 Ganesh Hansda, C/2265 Amit Ghosh both of Balarampur PS, Purulia was engaged in Dava Evening Mobile duty vide Balarampur PS CC No-3127/2024 dt-07.09.2024. In course of Dava Evening Mobile duty at about 19:05 hrs. I have received an information from a reliable source that one person has stored some illicit liquor at near Rangadih village under Balarampur P.S & selling the same to innocent people for his personal gain. Accordingly, I informed to O/C Balarampur P.S. regarding this matter and as per his direction I along with force left for Rangadih to work out this information. At about 19:25 hrs I along with force reached at Rangadih village and contacted with my source. From a reasonable distance my source has identified the place where the ID liquor has stored illegally. I along with force held raid and found that one person is selling ID liquor which is stored in a jarican. On seeing the Police party the person tried to flew but I along with force apprehend the person. On asking the apprehended person disclosed his name as Mansa Gorai (approx 45 years) S/O- Bhim Gorai of Vill-Rangadih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist. Purulia. On interrogation he confessed that he was selling the ID liquor in lieu of money for his personnel gain.

Myself along with force and the apprehended person search the place and found that he has stored ID liquor in a plastic jarican about 09 litres. On demand, he failed to produce any valid documents or valid License in respect of selling and keeping of said ID liquor. Accordingly, I seized 09 litters of ID liquor in a white plastic jarican from the possession of accused person after preparing proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses and the accused person. I also took 500 ML (Approx) ID liquor as sample in a plastic bottle from the mother container and sealed & labelled all the articles on the spot. The seizure procedure was done in between 19:40 hrs to 20:05 hrs. Mansa Gorai (approx 45 years) S/O- Bhim Gorai of Vill-Rangadih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist. Purulia has been arrested after preparing proper arrest memo as he committed offence U/S 46A(c) B.E. Act 1909 after maintaining all the formalities as per NHRC guide line.

The Audio & Videography of entire processes of search and seizure has been done. The videography has been stored in memory card which is enclosed here with.

Under the above circumstances, I therefore pray that a specific case may kindly be started U/S 46A(c) B.E. Act against the arrested accused person Mansa Gorai (approx 45 years) S/O- Bhim Gorai of Vill-Rangadih, P.S- Balarampur, Dist. Purulia and arrange for its investigation.
