Sub: Complaint
Sir,

In producing here with 01 (One) Tractor without Registration number (Engine No NHN30370ZKH482507) attached with trolley loaded with sand about 100 Cft. (Approx) with proper seizure list.

I beg to state that on 11.09.2024 myself along with force (i) C/1481 Gadadhar Biswas & (ii) C/960 Golak Bihari Mahato all of Barabazar PS performing Spl. mobile duty at PS area Vide Spl. C.C. No 19/2024 Dtd. 11.09.2024 and GDE No 636 Dt. 11.09.2024 with Govt vehicle. During my Spl. mobile duty received source information regarding loading and sending illegal sand from the side of Sankhari village area. Convey the same to you and as per your direction I along with force proceeded to Sankhari village area and reached at Sankhari Morh at about 12:15 hrs and found one tractor attached with trolley coming towards Sankhari Morh on Barabazar-Purulia Pitch Road and seeing the Police party the driver of said Tractor fled away after keeping the tractor beside the road near Sankhari Morh under Barabazar PS, chased him but somehow the driver managed to escape. Myself along with force found that the Tractor was loaded with Sand about 100 Cft. (approx). Myself along with force waiting for some time but none turned up before me for production of any valid documents regarding sand. There is every reason to believe that the owner and driver fraudulently obtained the sand by illegal means to make profit by illegal manners with a clandestine business. Hence I seized the tractor attached with trolley loaded with sand about 100 Cft. (approx) under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses at 12:35 hrs to 12:55 hrs.

I held an enquiry about the matter and so far information collected it is crystal clear that the driver and the owner of the vehicle collected the sand through illegal manner by unauthorized extraction and removal of mines & minerals. By this way they violated the regulation of procurement of mines & minerals. As such there is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the said tractor with ill motive were transporting the sand illegally without any valid document in support of carrying sand. As such they were doing illegal business activities.

Under the above facts and circumstance, I pray before you that kindly take needful action against the driver and owner of said tractor by lodging a specific case u/s proper section of law and arrange its investigation also.
