**Sub: Lodging of F.I.R of theft of Electricity against Dinabandhu majee, S/o Ratikanata Maji at his Domestic premises at Sankra, P.S.-Para and thereby committed an offence punishable U/S 135(1)(b) of Electricity Act 2003 amended in 2007.**

Dear Sir,

This is to inform you that, I Sri Sutanu Goswami, S/O – Sitiesh Chandra Goswami, A.E. & Station Manager of Anara CCC, WBSEDCL received an information to the effect that Dinabandhu majee, S/o Ratikanata Maji residing at Sankra was committing theft of Electricity at his Domestic premises by bypassing electricity by means of tapping from incoming side of the service cable.

Acting on this information this day 03.09.2024, I along with Sri Sayandeep Paul (JE - II), Gobinda mahato (Head assistant), Prabir Nandi (Spot billing supervisor), & Bapi Bauri (contractual technical staff) of Anara CCC had been to the house of Dinabandhu majee. He was present at his house. We contacted him and disclosed our identity to him. On being asked he allowed us to inspect the Energy meter of WBSEDCL installed at his domestic premises.

The premise is a one storied building. When asked about the meter he said the meter is situated inside a broken house from where the output has been taken to his premises where he lives. The meter is installed at the left side of the entrance of the broken house. A notice was prepared duly signed by the present user served upon the consumer and held inspection. During inspection, it was detected that, Dinabandhu majee had bypassed the electricity by means of tapping from incoming side of the service cable bearing meter No: L4618783 at the said premises. Tapping was done from the service cable which was binded using a shackle insulator anchored in the wall of a mandir. Inspection also revealed that Sri Dinabandhu majee was the actual user of the above mentioned service connection.

Immediately, on my direction the contractual worker (Bapi Bauri) disconnected the above mentioned service connection and removed the Energy meter bearing SI no: L4618783.

From the evidence so far collected from the inspection of the energy meter, it is well established that Dinabandhu majee was consuming Electricity illegally in his Domestic residence and for this activity of theft the WBSEDCL has incurred huge loss of revenue.

On inspection it is found that he was using the following apparatus :- 1) Led Light 3 Nos.(3\*10)=30w, 2) Fan 1 Nos. (1\*100)=100w, 3) TV 1 no. =200w, 4) cooking heater =1500w Total=1830 Watt.

I, Sri Sutanu Goswami, AE & SM of Anara CCC prepared inspection report in his presence i.e. present user (Dinabandhu majee) and witnesses at the spot and load assessed as 1.83 KW.

I, Sri Sutanu Goswami, AE & SM of Anara CCC prepared Seizure list in respect of the said premises and meter in presence of the present user and witnesses at the spot.

The inspection was held between 11.30 AM to 12.15 PM today after observing all legal formalities. It is well evident that accused Dinabandhu majee, S/o Ratikanata Maji of Sankra has committed offence punishable U/S 135(1)(b) of Electricity Act 2003 amended in 2007.

You are requested to take cognizance of this complain & treat it as FIR.
