Sub: Prayer for lodging FIR.

Sir,

In producing herewith the seized vehicle (Pick up Van) having registration No- WB 67B 8613 loaded with approx 2.5 Ton coal under proper seizure list before you to start a specific case.

I beg to state that today (05.09.2024) while I, SI Subrata Sarkar along with C/- 1137 Sridam Bauri & C/- 1182 Santosh Kr. Mahato both of Purulia (M) PS, Dist- Purulia vide Purulia (M) GDE No- 303 & C.C No- 2719/2024 Dtd. 05.09.2024 are performing evening night mobile duty at PS area, at about 21:35 hrs I received and information from my source that one vehicle (Pick up Van) having registration No- WB 67B 8613 loaded with illegal coal is going towards Hura side on Purulia - Hura road (NH). After receiving the information I contacted you and as per guidance and instruction we left that place to work out the information as well as to track and stop this illegal transportation of coal. After a long chase I managed to stop the vehicle beside Surulia Bus Stoppage under Purulia (M) PS at about 22:05 hrs. But seeing the Police parties the driver of the vehicle fled away after leaving the vehicle.

Accordingly, I along with the force intercepted the vehicle (Pick up Van) having registration No- WB 67B 8613 loaded with approx 2.5 Ton coal without a driver or any other person. I found that the vehicle as well as goods was identical as I received prior information. I moved through the surrounding area to trace the said driver or owner of said detained vehicle, but nobody was found to stand its ownership. On preliminary enquiry it could be learnt that the driver along with the owner of the said vehicle were procuring the said illegal coal from different places and transporting the same in a clandestine manner to another district/state. So, it is reasonable to believe that they were transporting the coal illegally after procuring by fraudulent means or theft by any means to transport the same to run a clandestine business.



Accordingly, finding no other alternative way I seized the vehicle having registration No- WB 67B 8613 loaded with coal approx 2.5 Ton coal under proper seizure list duly signed by the accompanied Police persons as there was no availability of any local person, as such I could not collect the signature of the local people in seizure list during seizure. I have taken 2 Kg of coal from the seized vehicle as a sample after preparing the proper level. The seizure was made between 22:15 to 22.25 hrs. The whole process of raid, seizure, labeling, arrest, has been videography.

After that we made a proper arrangement and brought the seized vehicle loaded with coal at PS for custody.

Therefore, I pray before you that a specific case may kindly be initiated against the owner and driver of coal loaded pick up van having registration No- WB 67B 8613 under proper section of law.
