Respected Sir,


In producing herewith (1) Approx 2000 Cft (Two thousand) sand, (2) Approx 70 ft (Seventy) Iron pipe, (3) Approx 10 (ten) ft PVC pipe, (4) 08 (Eight) nos of plastic drum. The fact of the case in brief is that on 11.09.24 myself along with force C/188 Debabrata Bauri and C/269 Lakhindar Tudu were performing special mobile duty on Sarbari - Saltora road. During mobile duty received a source information that some persons in Damodar river back side of ACC cement factory and in Damodar river near Dumdumi village under Santuri PS are mining and transporting sand illegally. Accordingly I informed the matter to O/C Santuri PS and as per his direction I along with force went there to work out the information.

Myself along with accompanying force reached at the bank of Damodar river back side of ACC cement factory at about 19: 15 hrs and found heap of sand approx 1000 cft is stacked on the bank of Damodar river & also found tyre marks on the spot. None was present there. Accordingly, I held local enquiry and it came to learn that one Sk Nadeem of Niyamatpur is engaged himself in mining and transporting of sand illegally from Damodar river since long. I searched the place carefully and seized 1) approx 1000 cft (One thousand) sand (2) Approx 70 ft (Seventy) Iron pipe, (3) Approx 10 (ten) ft PVC pipe, (4) 08 (Eight) nos of plastic drum under proper seizer list duly signed by the available witnesses. It is a lonely place and there is no movement of public there. Hence during seizure no public place was present there at the time of seizure. Then I along with accompanying force reached near Dumdumi village at a stretch of 100 mtr from the 1<sup>st</sup> place at 20:15 hrs and found heap of sand on the bank of Damodar river & also found tyre marks on the spot. I held local enquiry and came to know that 1. Kanai Majee of Balitora 2. Tapan Mitra of Madhukunda 3. Arup Mishra 4. Ramkrishna both are of Asansol are engaged themselves in mining and transporting of sand illegally from Damodar river since long. I seized 1) approx 1000 cft (One thousand) sand under proper seizer list duly signed by the available witnesses. Entire seizure process was audio & video graphed at both the places.


Under the above noted fact and circumstances there is every reason to believe that the above noted persons are engaged in extracting, lifting and transporting sand illegally and they are running this clandestine business for their wrongful gain and wrongful loss of Govt revenue. So the above noted persons have committed offence punishable U/S 303(2)/317(2)/317(4)/317(5)BNS & 21(I) (4) of Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act.

I therefore pray that a specific case may be started in this regard as per law and arrange for its investigation.
